### League News

Last weekend, League Secretary Nigel Wood, sent the following correspondence to all member clubs

As you may have all read on social media, the FA held a meeting on Thursday evening, which myself and the Chairman attended, where the proposed restart of competitive football at our level on 2nd December was discussed.

The FA reiterated that their key object remains "to conclude the 20/21 season and achieve promotion and relegation as a result, either by completing all fixtures or rely on a mathematical equation."

They also reported that at Steps 5 & 6 players/teams can travel between tiers, however for our level of football no spectators are allowed for those clubs situated in tier 3. In addition, we were also informed that clubs in tier 2 cannot open their clubhouses, other than to provide a takeaway service, which must be consumed off the premises i.e. outside of the ground.

Finance - As previously reported in the press, there is a sum of £14 million made available to clubs at steps 3 to 6, however 80% of that sum will be classed as loans, the remainder in grants, the terms regarding the loans have not yet been made public.

They closed by informing us that the FA Vase matches arranged for the next few Saturdays will go ahead, irrespective of which tier the competing clubs are in.

As you may remember, in June, it was stated that it was not sustainable for member clubs to play matches 'behind closed doors' for an undetermined length of time and that clubs also need the revenue from clubhouses and food sales, this view has not changed. The full Management Committee met yesterday to discuss the current situation and unanimously agreed that, as the vast majority of clubs in all Divisions have been placed in Tier 3, it is still unsustainable to expect clubs to play without any supporters.

Therefore, the decision has reluctantly been made to suspend the restart of all League fixtures until 19th December. We will then review the decision again on 16th December once the government has reviewed their tier levels.

In addition the Management Committee also agreed that, if fixtures do resume on 19th December that clubs can agree to switch their Boxing Day fixtures to 28th, 29th or 30th December to allow everyone to take advantage for the relaxation in the rules regarding families coming together this Christmas.

In closing, we have not taken this decision lightly, however we feel that it is the only practical and fair decision for all member clubs.

## Preview

### **Buildbase FA Vase 2<sup>nd</sup> Round Proper**

#### **Atherstone Town (MFL1 10<sup>th</sup>) vs Malvern Town (UHL1W 1<sup>st</sup>)**

The Adders have had a disappointing campaign to date with them currently sitting in mid-table in Division 1. Malvern have won nine of their ten league games this season with Harry Clark and Joe Bates scoring nineteen goals between them. The two sides met at the same stage last season and fought out an epic 3-3 draw at HDAnywhere Community Stadium before Atherstone won the replay 10-0. The Adders finally bowed out at the quarter final stage and they will be hoping for another extended run.

#### **Boldmere St Michaels (MFLP 15<sup>th</sup>) vs Newark (MFLP 4<sup>th</sup>)**

An all Premier Division game at The Trevor Brown Memorial Stadium. The Mikes reached this stage with a comfortable win at Shirebrook Town, this followed a remarkable 14-13 penalty shoot-out win at Winsford United in the previous round. The Highwaymen started the season in great form but were without a win in four when the league was suspended. This one could be decided by which team can shake off the ring rust the best

#### **Coventry United (MFLP 7<sup>th</sup>) vs Abbey Hulton United (NWC1S 18<sup>th</sup>)**

One team that has experience of playing in front of empty grounds is Coventry United who have not been able to have spectators at The Butts Park Arena this season. Whether this gives them an advantage over Stoke based Abbey Hulton United, will have to be seen. Coventry have gone through some major changes in the structure of the club over the past month and they will be hoping for a good FA vase run. Abbey have struggled in the league with only two points from six league games. They put this form to one side in the previous round when they beat Racing Club Warwick on penalties.

#### **Dudley Sports (WMRL 13<sup>th</sup>) vs Coventry Sphinx (MFLP 12<sup>th</sup>)**

Coventry Sphinx travel to the Black Country to face West Midlands side Dudley Sports at Hillcrest Avenue. While their league form has been mixed, Sports have had two fine FA Vase victories over Littleton and Rugby at home. Sports have some MFL experience in their side with David Meese and Nick Turton leading the scoring ranks. Sphinx had a big win over Heanor Town to reach round two and they have been finding the net with increasing regularity. Sphinx will be hoping that they can make their seniority count, but it will be tough.

#### **Long Eaton United (MFLP 3<sup>rd</sup>) vs Stone Old Alleynians (NWC1S 9<sup>th</sup>)**

Long Eaton have been one of the successes of the season to date, flying high in the Premier Division and averaging four goals per game in the process. Two successive 4-1 victories over Selston and Studley has seen them reach round two. OA's are mid table in the North West Counties One South and were in fine form before lockdown. They reached this round with victories over Dudley Town and AFC Mansfield. Long Eaton must start strong favourites to reach Round three.

### **Shepshed Dynamo (UCLP 4<sup>th</sup>) vs Worcester City (MFLP 16<sup>th</sup>)**

Worcester travel to former MFL side Shepshed Dynamo in what should be a cracker of a cup-tie. Dynamo have lost just once in the league and reached round two with a win over Melton Town. They have goals throughout the squad with well known names to the MFL, Matt Melbourne and Shay Brennan, regular contributors. City have had a tough start to the season with only one league win to their name. Away from home, they have conceded goals aplenty averaging almost three per game, which is one of the reasons for their league position. The Dovecote is a tough place to go but without crowds it will be somewhat less intimidating.

### **Sporting Khalsa (MFLP 1<sup>st</sup>) vs Aylestone Park (UCL1 10<sup>th</sup>)**

Premier Division league leaders Khalsa continue their love affair with the FA Vase with a home tie against mid table Step 6 side Aylestone Park. Park came from behind to beat Lye Town on penalties in the previous round which is enough of a result to send concerns to Khalsa. Aaron Preston and Besongbap Beck-Ray have scored 24 goals between them this season for Park and will pose a threat. Khalsa haven't played since the middle of October when they surrendered their unbeaten record at Long Eaton. They will be eager to get back to Noose Lane and surpass previous successful seasons in the competition.

### **Stourport Swifts (MFLP 2<sup>nd</sup>) vs Grimsby Borough (NECL 5<sup>th</sup>)**

Swifts are through to the second round after Skegness Town made the difficult decision to withdraw from the FA Vase due to travelling from a Tier 3 to a Tier 2 area. This brings North East Counties highflyers Grimsby Borough to Walshes Meadow for the only game in the Vase, featuring MFL clubs, to have a crowd. Swifts are having an excellent season and sit just behind Sporting Khalsa in second place. The form of Jack Watts, with eight goals this season, has been a key factor for free-scoring Swifts. Grimsby beat Quorn by a solitary goal to reach round two. Their home form is excellent but away from Bradley they have lost three out of four, conceding five on their last two away from home.

### **Walsall Wood (MFLP 11<sup>th</sup>) vs AFC Bridgnorth (WMRL 15<sup>th</sup>)**

Walsall Wood welcome Shropshire based Bridgnorth to Oak Park. The Wood will be disappointed with their league campaign so far and they have reserved their better performances for home turf. Goals have not been flowing but the addition of Romario Martin from Highgate United has begun to make an impact. The Meadowmen are struggling in the league but have two excellent away wins at Pershore Town and Harrowby United to get to this stage. Tom Grainger scored a hat-trick in their last away league game, a 6-5 win at Bewdley Town and they will be hoping to kick on from there.
