## Review

### Premier Division

Two George Forsyth goals earned **Worcester City** a 2-0 win at **Shepshed Dynamo** to keep in contact with the top two.

**Bromsgrove Sporting** extended their lead to 4-points ahead of Monday's fixture at Coleshill Town following a 3-0 win over **Shepshed Dynamo**. **Shawbury United** climb out of the bottom three with a fine 1-0 win at **Loughborough University**, Jordan Jones on target on the stroke of half-time. **Haughmond** are a point behind their Shropshire rivals as they were held 2-2 at The Sports Village by **Lye Town**. A double from Stuart Hendrie helped **Rugby Town** to a 3-1 win at 10-man **Coventry Sphinx**. **Quorn** climb to 13<sup>th</sup> with a 2-0 win at **Long Eaton United** who drop back to 8<sup>th</sup>.

Leaders **Bromsgrove Sporting** opened up a 7-point lead at the top of the table, avenging their recent home defeat at the hands of **Coleshill Town**, by winning 4-2 at Pack Meadow. Richard Gregory and Jason Cowley both scored twice as Sporting took a 4-0 lead with The Coleman scoring twice in the last 7 minutes. **Shawbury United** came from 2-0 down at home to **Haughmond** to snatch a point with two goals in the last quarter of an hour.
