Review

FA Vase 1st Round, Qualifying

GNP Sports began the FA Vase weekend on Friday evening with a 3-2 win over Littleton at Sphinx Drive, Chris Lloyd scoring twice.

Boldmere St Michaels and **Stourport Swifts** met for the second time in a week and it was the Mikes that won through to the 2nd qualifying round following a 3-2 win. **Coventry Copsewood** travelled to **Bolehall Swifts** and the game was goalless until just before half-time when Copsewood took the lead through Isa Abraham. Four further goals followed as Copsewood won 5-0. Joel Dyche scored twice as **Uttoxeter Town** won 4-0 at Bromyard Town. Former MFL side Shawbury United won 3-0 at **Coton Green**, Tom Hughes scoring twice. **Newark Flowserve** scored two goals in the last 17 minutes to progress through with a 3-1 win at County Hall. **Coventry Sphinx** beat **AFC Wulfrunians** 2-1 at Sphinx Drive, a Callum Woodward penalty being the winning goal. A goal two minutes into stoppage time from Albert Lansdowne earned **Gresley** a much needed win at home to Winsford United. **Haughmond** eased past Stone Old Alleynians at The Sports Village, 3-1 the final score. **Heather St Johns** continued their cup exploits with a 3-0 win over Hereford Pegasus at St John's Park. **Highgate United** went goal crazy beating Ellistown 11-1 at The Coppice, Stuart Hendrie scored three and Corey Carrithers two. Lewis Pointon scored both goals for **Ashby Ivanhoe** in their 2-1 extra-time win at **Heath Hayes**. **Hinckley AFC** came from behind to beat Ellesmere Rangers 2-1 at The Welfare ground. Joe Simpson scored an extra time winner for **Kirby Muxloe** as they beat Oakham United 3-2. **Leicester Road** made comfortable progress against Dudley Sports, 3-1 the scoreline. Result of the round was at The City Ground as Division 1 **Lichfield City** beat Premier Division **Romulus** 5-2. James Taylor scored a hat-trick of penalties for City as they collected another giant killing scalp. There was a great result at The Pingles Stadium as **Nuneaton Griff** beat nine man Wellington Amateurs 5-3 after extra time. Ryan Slinn was the hero for Griff with a hat-trick. Tory Herbert scored twice for **Racing Club Warwick** in their 4-0 win over AFC Bridgnorth at Townsend Meadow. **South Normanton Athletic** continued their fine form with a 7-0 win over Ollerton Town, Richard Hanslow scored three and Martin Smyth two for the Shiners. Darragh Bustin scored twice for **Tividale** in their 3-1 win at **Stafford Town**. Two goals in the last 17 minutes sent Dudley Town through at the expense of **Stapenhill**, 2-0 the scoreline. **Studley** beat fellow Division 1 side **Brocton** 3-2 at The Beehive, Dale Edwards amongst the scorers again. **Worcester City** travelled to the outskirts of Hereford and progressed through to the next round with a 5-0 defeat of Wellington. Jordan Harrison and Demetri Brown both scoring twice for City.

FA Cup 1st Qualifying Round

Halesowen Town (SL1C) vs Lichfield City (MFL1)

Halesowen were relegated from Step 3 last season but have started well with 4 wins from 6 starts this season. New manager Paul Smith has built a good squad with many familiar faces from the MFL. Lichfield have made a storming start to the season and have already beaten 3 higher ranked sides in cup competitions this season. The Yeltz will start as favourites but Lichfield have a decent chance

Kirby Muxloe (MFL1) vs Boston Town (UCLP)

Kirby entertain Boston Town who are without a win in the league this season. They come into the game on the back of a thumping defeat at Quorn in the FA Vase. In the FA Cup, they have needed replays on both occasions to make it through. Kirby have reached this round with two away wins without conceding a goal. Home advantage could be the key.
