Review

Buildbase FA Vase Round 2

Cadbury Athletic raced into a 3-0 lead at home to **Heather St Johns** but 2 goals from Chris Lloyd gave the Saints hope. The Chocolatemens held on to reach round 3. Three first half goals ensured **Coventry United** progressed as they beat league rivals **Boldmere St Michaels** 3-0 at The Butts Park Arena. Sam Belcher scored twice as **Hinckley AFC** made it into the third round with a 3-1 win over WMRL Hereford Lads Club. Two goals in the last ten minutes put the gloss on the scoreline as **Lye Town** beat **Brocton** 4-1 at The Sports ground. **Quorn** were the only MFL team to lose to a side from another league as they were beaten 2-1 by Eastwood Community at Farley Way despite taking a one goal lead into the break. **Shepshed Dynamo** took their league form into the Vase to beat Blidworth Welfare 3-0 at The Dovecote. Dan Westwood scored a hat-trick to give **Sporting Khalsa** a 3-0 lead at home to Hucknall Town. Adam Nelson scored twice for Hucknall in the last 10 minutes and they also hit the bar as Khalsa were relieved at the final whistle. **NKF Burbage** caused a shock winning 2-0 at Premier Division **Stourport Swifts**, Jesse Adcock and Nathan Astill with the goals. **Walsall Wood** eased past Dronfield Town, 3-1 the score at Oak Park. **Westfields** hosted league rivals **Romulus** and took a 2-0 lead early in the second half. The Roms responded to draw level but Keanu Cooper had the final say for the home side, scoring the winner in the 80th minute. Premier Division leaders **Ilkeston Town** took an 8th minute lead at **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** and they doubled it with 7 minutes remaining to go through to the next round.

Worcester City became the 2nd MFL side to be beaten at home by a team from another league when Desborough Town scored two second half goals to win 2-0 at The Victoria ground. Both teams were reduced to ten men in the second half.
