## Review

### Buildbase FA Vase Round 4

**Coventry United** are the sole survivors into Round 5 as Antonia Zamora clinched a 3-2 win in time added on against Leicester Nirvana. The visitors went ahead only for Arum Soleman to equalise within 4 minutes. Kai Williams gave United the lead, but Nirvana equalised through Suleman Nassor. This is how it stayed until the dramatic late winner.

**Sporting Khalsa** were knocked out of the Vase by Thurlow Nunn league leaders Godmanchester Rovers. Mike Hyem scored the only goal of the game to give Goddy a deserved victory. **Shepshed Dynamo** took the lead at Vase favourites Hebburn Town and then missed a penalty before the home side equalised at the end of the first half. Luke Sullivan settled the tie in Hebburn's favour just after the break. Jack Till gave **Lye Town** the lead at Histon but two goals from skipper Max York before half-time gave the Stutes victory. **Cadbury Athletic** flew the flag for Division 1 and they found Hallmark Securities Irlam too hot to handle as the Manchester based side progressed with a 4-0 victory.

## Premier Division

Alex Marshall scored twice as **Ilkeston Town** extended their lead at the top of the table with a 3-0 win over **Romulus** at New Manor Ground. 2<sup>nd</sup> placed **Walsall Wood** took a first minute lead at **AFC Wulfrunians** but Wulfs responded with two of their own to win 2-1. **Westfields** move into 3<sup>rd</sup> place following a 2-2 draw at **Quorn**. Former Hereford striker, John Mills, made a goalscoring debut for Fields who were pegged back by Shay Brennan. Two converted penalties from Rikardo Reid gave the Mikes the lead and they eventually ran out 4-1 victors. **Loughborough University** climb to 16<sup>th</sup> with a 3-2 win over **Stourport Swifts** with Connor Smith scoring twice.

League leaders **Ilkeston Town** opened a 7 point gap at the top as they beat bottom club **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** 6-1 at the New Manor Ground. Jamie Walker scored 2 and leading scorer followed up with a hat-trick for the rampant Robins. **Shepshed Dynamo** are up to 5<sup>th</sup>, Josh Thomas scoring twice in a 3-1 win over **Loughborough University**.

**Walsall Wood** lost for the second time in a week and missed a penalty as they went down to an Arum Soleman goal at **Coventry United**, who move up to 12<sup>th</sup>.
