**Hinckley AFC** are pleased to confirm that we have signed an agreement to play home matches in 2018-19 at Ibstock Miners Welfare Sports and Social Club.

The club signed an agreement with Ibstock Parish Council, the owners of the land, last week as the club brings to an end a four-year association with Heather St John's.

The deal has been lodged with the Total Motion Midland Football League, with the ground already having passed the grading to host step six football.



The exciting move will also bring together the first team and Under 18 side for the first time, with Simon Mellor's youth side using the Welfare Ground as their home for this season. Sunday league side Sporting Dynamo also use the venue.

Councillor Stuart Farmer, Chairman of Ibstock Parish Council, said: "We're delighted to welcome Hinckley AFC to Ibstock. Their tenancy will breathe new life into the ground."

Hinckley AFC director Gerry Abbott said: "We're excited about this new chapter for the club. Whilst our aim of returning to Hinckley is still a priority for us, the move to Ibstock will allow the club to attain a more stable financial footing."

The club would like to the opportunity to again thank Heather St John's for their hospitality since the creation of the club, and their willingness to share their ground gave AFC a place to call home while the club found its feet.

## Review

### Premier Division

A goal from George Forsyth gave **Worcester City** all 3 points at home to **Westfields** to close the gap to 2<sup>nd</sup> place to just 4 points. A Richard Batchelor goal 6 minutes from time earned **Highgate United** all 3 points at **Stourport Swifts**. **Quorn** came from behind to beat **Shepshed Dynamo** 3-1 in a game switched to Farley Way. There was a remarkable game at The Sports Village where visitors **Boldmere St Michaels** were reduced to 10 men after just two minutes against **Haughmond**. Twice behind, The Mikes ran out 4-2 winners, Ben Usher-Shipway with a brace, to severely dent Haughmond's survival hopes.

**Highgate United** were the big winners on a day of fluctuations at the top of the table. An Aaron Brown penalty gave Gate all three points at home to **Boldmere St Michaels**. The result means Highgate are 5 points behind second place with three games in hand. Leaders **Bromsgrove Sporting** were 2-0 down after 16 minutes at **Long Eaton United** but earned a draw with second half goals from Jason Cowley and Richard Gregory. 2<sup>nd</sup> placed **Coleshill Town** were 2-0 in front at half-time over visitors **Shepshed Dynamo** but goals from Shay Brennan and Liam Hurst gave Dynamo a point. **Worcester City** were also pegged back to draw at home to **Rugby Town** with Stuart Hendrie equalising a Dave Reynolds wonder goal in the first half. **Sporting Khalsa** inflicted more misery on bottom club **Rochester**, 4-0 the score at the CKW Stadium. **South Normanton Athletic** drew level on points with Shawbury United in the battle to avoid the drop following a 3-2 win over **Lye Town**, Jack Tyson scoring twice. A late equaliser from Cameron Gordon for **Loughborough University** at home to **Westfields** meant that the students are 3 points clear of the drop zone. **Coventry Sphinx** remain 6<sup>th</sup> as they shared four goals with **AFC Wulfrunians** at Sphinx Drive.

Two goals from Jason Cowley edged **Bromsgrove Sporting** to a derby day win over **Worcester City** at The Victoria ground in front of 1,423. **Highgate United** are up to 3<sup>rd</sup> and are just two points off a promotion place following their 4-1 win over **Haughmond** at The Coppice, Aaron Brown scoring twice. Lee Chilton scored a hat-trick for **Lye Town** as they beat **AFC Wulfrunians** 4-1 at Sturbridge Road. **Sporting Khalsa**' faint hopes of finishing in the top two are almost over as they were beaten 2-1 at **Rugby Town**, Stuart Hendrie with the winner. **Rochester** remain 13 points adrift of safety as they were beaten 4-2 at Hillsfield by **Westfields** for whom Aiden Thomas scored a first-half hat-trick.

## Division 1

**Ilkeston Town** moved to within 4 points of leaders Walsall Wood with a 3-1 win at **Coventry Copsewood**. Jamie Walker scored twice in the first half to send the Robins on their way. There was another goalfest at St Johns Park as **Hinckley AFC** and **Racing Club Warwick** shared 8 goals. The Racers took a 2-0 lead inside 12 minutes but a hat-trick from Steve Hart and a goal from Luke Richards looked to have given Hinckley the points. Back came Warwick with Martin Slevin equalising from the penalty spot in the 87<sup>th</sup> minute.

Leaders **Walsall Wood** need 14 points to clinch the title as they beat relegation threatened **Stafford Town** 5-0 at Evans Park, Kyle Rowley scoring twice. 2<sup>nd</sup> place **Ilkeston Town** had a one-man advantage over visitors **Studley** from the 18<sup>th</sup> minute but it took until the 78<sup>th</sup> minute for Tim Hopkinson to score the winner. **Leicester Road** stay in 3<sup>rd</sup> place with a fine 5-2 win at **Lichfield City**. **Hinckley AFC** beat **Coventry Copsewood** 3-2 at St Johns Park, all the goals in the first half. The league's leading scorer Simeon Cobourne scored a hat-trick of penalties as **Heather St Johns** won 6-2 at **Paget Rangers**. Alfie Bloomer scored the only goal of the game as **Pershore Town** beat **Racing Club Warwick** at Townsend Meadow, **Uttoxeter Town** continued their superb recent form with a 2-0 win at **Nuneaton Griff**. At the foot of the table, **Bolehall Swifts** moved two points clear of Stafford Town following a 1-1 draw at **Brocton**. **Heath Hayes** and **Chelmsley Town** sit in 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> after the pair drew 1-1 at Coppice Colliery Ground. **Littleton** chances of a top 8 finish diminished with a 3-1 defeat at home to **Cadbury Athletic** at 5 Acres with Stuart Butcher scoring twice for The Chocolatememen.

**Walsall Wood** moved 7 points clear at the top with a resounding 6-0 win over **Coventry Copsewood**. Paul Sullivan netted a hat-trick while there was also a double for Ben Lund. **Atherstone Town** broke the 100 goal mark for the season as 5 different scorers netted in a 5-0 win over relegation threatened **Bolehall Swifts**. Luke Cole scored twice for **Racing Club Warwick** in their 4-0 win over **Brocton** at Silkmore Lane. **Lichfield City** came from behind to beat **Nuneaton Griff** 3-1 at McDonalds Community Stadium. **Heather St Johns** were held to a goalless draw at St Johns Park by **Pershore Town**.
