They entertain **Kirby Muxloe** this weekend with Kirby yet to win away from home this season. **Lichfield City** are clear in second and they travel to the TSA to face **Cadbury Athletic** who are unbeaten in five home league games. 6th meets 3rd at The Beehive with **Studley** hosting **Uttoxeter Town**. Studley have drawn three of their last four leaving them four points adrift of their visitors. Uttoxeter have four wins and a draw from their last five league games, the draw being a remarkable 4-4 encounter at Leicester Road. **Coventry Copsewood** scored eight in midweek and have been climbing the table rapidly of late. They entertain 5th placed **Hinckley AFC** who have picked up seven points from their previous three games. **Atherstone Town** welcome **Ashby Ivanhoe** to Sheepy Road.
