### Premier Division

**Ilkeston Town** maintained their 4 point league at the top of the table with a come from behind win at home to **AFC Wulfrunians**. Elliott Reeves scored twice for the Robins just before half-time to set the Robins on their way. 2<sup>nd</sup> placed **Westfields** won 2-1 at **Lye Town** with Craig Jones scoring the winner four minutes into stoppage time. A Jordan Nadat goal midway through the first half settled the game at Oak Park in **Walsall Wood's** favour over bottom club **South Normanton Athletic**. **Sporting Khalsa** are 4<sup>th</sup> with games in hand after a Dan Westwood double gave them all three points at **Coventry United**. **Worcester City** slip to 5th following an 88<sup>th</sup> minute equaliser from Chris Enemeradu gave **Loughborough University** a share of the spoils at The Victoria Ground. A Callum Woodward penalty in the second half earned **Coventry Sphinx** a 1-1 draw at **Stourport Swifts**. **Shepshed Dynamo** continue their good run of form with 2-1 win over **Highgate United** at The Dovecote. **Romulus** had a welcome return to form as they beat 10 man **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** 4-0 with Lewis Commins scoring twice. **Dunkirk** are just a point adrift of safety following a 2-0 win over **Quorn** at Lenton Lane. **Long Eaton United** won their second game on the trot to climb to 16<sup>th</sup> as they beat **Boldmere St Michaels** 2-1 at Grange Park.

Leaders **Ilkeston Town** played three quarters of the game at **Highgate United** with 10 men after Paolo Pileo had been sent off. Credit to Lichfield as they pulled a goal back through Jordan Evans, but Joe Obi killed the game off with 7 minutes left. Great entertainment for the crowd of 286. **Racing Club Warwick** are up to 2<sup>nd</sup> following a 3-2 win at **Brocton**. Ben Mackey scored twice including a controversial penalty to set up next weekend's clash at home to Atherstone.
