Review

League Cup Final

Romulus 2 NKF Burbage 1 Att:349

Premier Division Romulus lifted the league cup in front of a healthy crowd of 349 at Bescot Stadium.

Romulus had a great chance to open the scoring in the 5th minute when leading scorer Luke Keen beat NKF Burbage keeper Alec Hill but saw his shot miss the target. Burbage first attack of note came with a right wing cross which just evaded the outstretched leg of Jess Adcock. Roms took the lead on the half-hour mark. Excellent work by Keen on the edge of the area allowed the ball to break for Max Loveridge. His shot appeared to be heading for the bottom corner but Keen, showing all the goal poaching skills of a striker, made sure rom within the 6-yard box. The goal settled Romulus and Keen had a chance to make it two but cleared the bar with his effort. In the 38th minute, Romulus should have doubled their lead. Etan Delaney was played through on goal, and one-on-one with keeper Hill, it was the Burbage keeper that won the battle, saving with his legs. A driving run by Burbage skipper Tom Smith ended with a poor finish but on the stroke of half-time he drew Burbage level. Poor defending by Romulus and the ball fell invitingly to Smith in front of goal and he hammered the ball into the roof of the net.

Romulus went close to reclaiming the lead 8 minutes into the second half. Burbage keeper Hill made two wonderful saves, the second from Kris Taylor after Keen had rattled the underside of the crossbar. Hill was called into action again making a comfortable near post save from Ryan Winwood. Hill again kept Romulus at bay on the hour mark as Taylor set-up Keen. His shot was well saved by Hill with Loveridge's follow up effort off target. Theo Llewellyn was next to test the Burbage keeper with a shot straight at him. With the game entering the final 10 minutes, Smith curled a shot just wide for Burbage before Roms regained the lead. Keen turned provider, picking out Delaney whose low shot flew past Hill into the bottom corner. Roms skipper Cameron Lee made an impressive break from his own half but the finish was that of a centre back rather than a forward. Keen was close to clinching the win when he spun his defender and forced Hill to yet another excellent parried stop. With a minute left on the clock, Tristan Atkinson had a rare chance for Burbage, but his volley was well wide. Three minutes into stoppage time, Keen was stopped in his tracks by an excellent challenge from Liam Storer.

Les James Challenge Cup Final

Knowle 1 Redditch Borough 2 Att:203

Redditch Borough overturned a one goal deficit to lift the Les James Challenge Cup at Bescot Stadium

Knowle should have taken the lead in the 5th minute. A cross from Louis Bridges picked out Steve Ruck, in front of goal and with only the goalkeeper to beat, he headed wide. A long throw from Jak Albutt caused problems in the Knowle defence before the ball was hacked to safety. Redditch keeper Josh Gandy had to gather bravely at the feet of Corey Powell as Knowle looked like opening the scoring. Redditch were awarded a free-kick in the 10th minute but Billy Garvey's shot was into the wall. Garvey was proving to be a thorn in Knowle's side, and he tested keeper Craig Johnson who made a comfortable save. In the 25th minute Knowle opened the scoring. A corner from Jay Payne was met by Louis Bridges and it flicked off a defender and onto the crossbar. Payne again delivered the corner and this time Bridges made no mistake powering home a header. Three minutes later, another Knowle corner saw Bridges header headed away from danger. Knowle wasted another chance to extend their lead when Powell's cross was headed wide by George Seeley. The game took a turn in the 35th minute when Garvey was bundled over in the penalty area by Callum Ingram. Garvey dusted himself down and made no mistake from the spot. Within a minute, Redditch completed the turnaround as they took the lead much to the delight of the large Borough following. The impressive Callum Hall had a shot blocked and when the ball was played back into the box, Khurum Iqbal picked his spot and shot across Johnson into the corner.

The first clear chance of the second half fell to Redditch when a ball over the top found Albutt and his shot was saved by Johnson. Garvey attempted an ambitious overhead kick which flew wide of the mark. Knowle had a chance to draw level in the 68th minute when Albert Davis headed wide from a corner. Knowle should have levelled three minutes later when Collins Ajayi headed a cross from Bridges over the bar. With seven minutes of added time announced by the officials, there was always going to be one chance in stoppage time, and it fell to Ajayi whose curling effort was off target. After 9 minutes of stoppage time, the final whistle signalled a deserved win on the night for Redditch Borough
