Review

Buildbase FA Vase Round 1

Haughmond bowed out of the competition on Friday evening losing 3-1 to Loughborough University. A stoppage time goal from Christian Oldham for Haughmond sent the game into extra-time but The Scholars took the tie with two added goals.

Atherstone Town are through to round 2 following a 3-1 win over Sandbach United at The Mark Webster Community Stadium. **GNP Sports** and Malvern Town played out a thriller at Sphinx Drive. GNP took a 2-0 lead, but Malvern came back and equalised late on to take the game into extra-time. Two goals from Ethan Moran settled the game in the favour of the Hillsiders, 4-2 the final score. A goal from Jazz Luckie 12 minutes from time enabled Rugby Town to win 1-0 at **Gresley**. Jamie Sleigh scored twice as Step 6 Heanor Town beat **Boldmere St Michaels** 3-0 at The Town Ground. There was a dramatic end to the game between **Leicester Road** and **Walsall Wood**. The tie was goalless after 90 minutes and Mitch Tolley gave The Wood the lead from the penalty spot in the first half of extra time. With just three minutes left on the clock, Callum Earls scored with an acrobatic overhead kick to appear to earn the Road a deserved replay. This was not to be as Max Loveridge slotted past Will Highland in the last minute to send the Wood through. There was also extra time at The City Ground as West Midlands League Dudley Town won 2-1 at **Lichfield City**. There was another dramatic finish this time at Lowfields as **Newark Flowserve** beat **Heather St Johns** 2-1. Ben Hutchinson scored twice for the home side with the winner coming in the 5th minute of stoppage time. **Worcester City** travelled to Lincolnshire and were comfortable winners, 3-0 at Pinchbeck United.
