In relation to a possible restart of fixtures, and following consultation with Premier & Division One Clubs, the Board have agreed the following: -

Premier & Division One Teams

Following the FA statement with regard to the return of spectators and the recent consultation, which resulted in the majority of Premier & Division One clubs indicating that they were prepared to resume playing League fixtures on 19th December, due consideration of the current situation has been given to a possible restart and therefore fixtures from 19th December up to 31st December will take place if both clubs wish to play. If you do not feel that it is safe to play please inform your opponents and the Fixture Secretary at least 72 hours before the scheduled kick off time of the fixture in question, the match will then be postponed until the next available date.

Without any further restrictions being imposed we expect a full resumption of fixtures from Saturday 2nd January.

Please make yourself aware of the restrictions regarding away supporters.

Division Two, Three, Reserve & Under 21

Under the current tier restrictions, and also taking into account the ban on travelling between tiers the Board have made the decision to suspend all fixtures until 2nd January at the earliest, pending a review of the tier system by the Government, following which a further update will be communicated.

The management committee of the MFL will meet again on December 29th to confirm plans for football in January.

Buildbase FA Vase Round 3

Coventry Sphinx (MFLP 12th) vs Anstey Nomads (UCLP 1st)

Sphinx welcome United Counties league leaders Anstey Nomads to the Ryona Engineering Supplies Stadium. Sphinx reached this round with a penalty shootout win at Dudley Sports. This followed a 6-1 win over Heanor Town at Sphinx Drive. Youngster Jamal Adams leads the scoring charts with eight goals this season. Anstey are having a fine season winning nine and drawing one of their ten league games. Two single goal home wins has seen them reach the 3rd round with Leicester Nirvana and Rainworth MW being their victims. Thirteen different players have made their way onto the scoresheet this season with Corey Armeni and Zayn Hakeem leading the way with seven apiece. Should be a real humdinger of a cup tie

Congleton Town (NWCP 6th) vs Coventry United (MFLP 7th)

A tough trip to Cheshire for Coventry United to face a strong Bears outfit. Congleton reached the 3rd round with a penalty shoot-out win over New Mills. In the previous round, they had a thumping win over Gresley Rovers which showed their credentials. The North West Counties league season hasn't started in earnest with most clubs having played just the five games. United made it to the third round with a 3-2 win over Abbey Hulton United at The Butts Park Arena. They have been finding the net with ruthless efficiency and have a 100% record away from home this season.

Long Eaton United (MFLP 3rd) vs Hanley Town (NWCP 3rd)

This promises to be an excellent game with both sides 3rd in their respective Step 5 divisions. Long Eaton have had an excellent start to the campaign in both league and cup. They have scored eleven goals in their three victories in the Vase this season and were narrowly beaten in the FA Cup at Step 3 Hednesford Town. Their home form has been excellent with Alex Marshall leading the way with twelve goals. Hanley have had some excellent cup wins this season beating Lye Town, Gresley Rovers and Redditch United in the FA Cup before victories over Eccleshall and Loughborough University in the FA Vase. Kieran Brown tops the scorechart with 12 goals while former Stoke City and Jamaica striker, Ricard Fuller, remains in the squad and scored the winner in midweek against Stone Old Alleynians.

Malvern Town (H1W 1st) vs Sporting Khalsa (NFLP 1st)

Two league leaders go head to head at the HD Anywhere Stadium. Malvern Town are top of the Hellenic League One West, the only Step 6 side involved in a tie with MFL opposition in the 3rd round. Malvern were back in league action last weekend picking up their 10th win in eleven games. In the Vase, they have beaten Atherstone Town and Rothwell Corinthians to reach round three. Harry Clark, Joe Bates, and Matt Turner have scored 26 goals between them for the Hillsiders. Khalsa beat Aylestone Park 4-1 to reach round three and they come into the game having dropped just five points in the league this season. Jake Gosling has scored ten goals this season from midfield with ten other players chipping in.

Newark (MFLP 4th) vs Walsall Wood (MFLP 11th)

An all MFL tie which guarantees league involvement into 2021. Newark beat Boldmere St Michaels by the odd goal in seven to reach round three. Before the league was put on hold, Newark were without a win in three games at Lowfields and this will be something they will need to put right if they are to continue their run in this competition. Danny Meadows has eleven goals to his name this season and he bagged a brace in the win at The Mikes, as did Craig Westcarr. Walsall Wood reached round three with a comfortable 3-0 win over AFC Bridgnorth at Oak Park. League form has been patchy, but they did enter the break on the back of a 4-0 win at Heather St Johns. When the two sides met in the league at Lowfields, Newark edged the game 2-1. This one will be as tight again

Stourport Swifts (MFLP 2nd) vs Shepshed Dynamo (UCLP 5th)

Swifts welcome former MFL side Shepshed to Walshes Meadow, Swifts reached round three with two 3-1 victories over Uttoxeter Town and Grimsby Borough, respectively. They are unbeaten since the end of September and have scored 21 goals in their last six games. Young striker Jack Watts has been a real find with eleven goals this season. Shepshed have won both their Vase games 3-2 over Melton Town and Worcester City. Their game against Worcester saw them come back from two down with six minutes left to turn it round with a stunning 92nd minute winner from Lim Canavan. Shepshed are unbeaten away from home in the league this season, so something must give.

Premier Division

6th placed **Gresley Rovers** are also eyeing the top four as they welcome 8th placed **AFC Wulfrunians** to The Moat Ground. Gresley have won their last five games at home but they come into the game on the back of three successive away defeats. Wulfs are on an excellent run and are unbeaten in eight games, their last defeat at the hands of Uttoxeter Town in the FA Vase. Their only league defeat came on the opening day of the season and a win for them would take a top six spot. At the foot of the table. **Selston** welcome **Lye Town** to Parish Hall. Selston picked up their first point of the season last time out and will be hoping that that was the catalyst for things to come.
