Review

FA Vase, 2nd Qualifying Round

Two goals from Aaron Knight helped Sandbach United to a 3-0 win at **Ashby Ivanhoe**. Brady Middleton scored a hat-trick as **Atherstone Town** came from behind to beat **Paget Rangers** 3-1 at Mark Webster Community Stadium. **Leicester Road** went goal crazy way to Black Country Rangers romping to an 8-0 victory. Simon Alcott scored a first half-trick before The Road closed the game out with 5 different scorers late in the second half. **Boldmere St Michaels** went a goal down at home to Willenhall Town but 4 goals in the final half hour saw them through 4-1. What a game at The Ryona Engineering Supplies Stadium. Hanley Town took an early lead, but **Coventry Sphinx** went into the break winning 2-1. Hanley then went 4-2 up before Sphinx equalised with 5 minutes remaining. Tim Barras finished the game for Hanley scoring the winner in the 3rd minute of stoppage time. It finished 5-4 to Hanley with Callum Woodward scoring twice for the home side. **FC Stratford** and **GNP Sports** fought out a 2-2 draw at The Arden Garages Stadium. The game went to penalties and GNP prevailed 4-3. Albert Lansdowne scored twice as **Gresley** came from behind to beat Oswestry Town 3-2 at The Moat Ground. Premier Division highflyers **Heather St Johns** are on the cup trail again as they beat **Coventry Copsewood** 5-2 at St John's Park, Kieron Clarke with a brace. **Rochester** overcame **Hinckley AFC** for the second Saturday in succession with Jordan Dodd scoring a late winner for the Roms, 3-2 at The Welfare Ground. Dan Griffiths scored twice as free-scoring **Lichfield City** overcame Wolverhampton Casuals 4-2 at The City Ground. Niall Towle scored twice as **Long Eaton United** made it through to the first round with a 3-0 win over Blackstones at Grange Park. Malvern Town raced into a 5-0 lead by half-time against **NKF Burbage** and despite pulling two goals back, Burbage had left themselves too much to do. **Newark Flowserve** are through to Round 1 following a 5-1 win over Skegness Town at Lowfields. Both sides finished with 10 men with Kyle Dixon scoring twice for Newark. Richard Hanslow scored twice for **South Normanton Athletic** as they **beat Kirby Muxloe** 2-1, another game which saw a red card for each side. A goal from Harry Morris 11 minutes from time was enough to earn **Haughmond** a victory in the Shropshire derby at Shifnal Town. Droitwich Spa provided a shock, belying the two step difference by winning 2-1 at **Tividale**. **Racing Club Warwick** are through to round 1, beating **Studley** 2-1 at the Beehive. A goal from Doug Price earned **Uttoxeter Town** a 1-0 win over Wolverhampton Sporting Community at Oldfields. Tim Hopkinson scored a hat-trick as West Bridgford beat **Selston** 5-0. Former Northern Ireland international, Steve Jones, scored a hat-trick for Whitchurch Alport in their 4-1 win over **Nuneaton Griff**. **Worcester City** beat **Highgate United** 2-0 and it was an eventful game for Sean Brain who scored City's second before being sent off in the second half.
