Review

FA Vase

AFC Wulfrunians were knocked out of the competition, a goal two minutes into stoppage time giving Wellington a 2-1 win at CKW Stadium. **Loughborough University** travelled to Arnold Town and made serene progress with a 5-0 win, Matty Crookes scoring twice. Doubles for Chris Cowley and Chris Lloyd saw **Heather St Johns** through 4-0 at Birstall United Social. **Boldmere St Michaels** are through to Round 1 following a 3-0 win at The TBMG over **Studley**. **Brocton** beat league rivals **Nuneaton Griff** 4-0 at Silkmore Lane with Lee Osborne scoring twice. Two goals in the first 17 minutes saw **Cadbury Athletic** home with a 2-0 win over Wem Town. **Chelmsley Town** took on WMRL favourites Tividale at Pack Meadow and had an excellent 3-1 win with Jordan Wade scoring twice. **Coventry Copsewood** entertained Hereford Lads Club and it was the WMRL side that went home happy with a 2-1 win. **Atherstone Town** took a 3rd minute lead at **Coventry United** however 2 goals from Kyle Carey gave the home side victory. **Ilkeston Town** travelled to in-form Graham Street Prims but goals from Ryan Whitehurst and Elliott Reeves saw them through 2-0. **Dunkirk** twice came from behind to equalise at Heanor Town but a penalty three minutes into added time gave the former MFL side victory, 3-2 the final score. **Littleton** hosted WMRL Smethwick and it was the visitors that made progress with a 51st minute goal. **Lye Town** were made to fight all the way as they beat Division 2 **Bolehall Swifts** 2-0 at Stourbridge Road.
