## Review

### Premier Division

**Walsall Wood** closed the gap in 2<sup>nd</sup> to juts 4 points following a 2-0 win at **South Normanton Athletic**. 3<sup>rd</sup> placed **Westfields** needed an injury time penalty from John Mills to rescue a point with a 2-2 draw at Allpay Park with **Romulus**. Two goals from Jay Holdcroft gave **Sporting Khalsa** an important 2-0 win at **Coventry Sphinx** to move within 8 points of the leaders with two games in hand. Bottom club **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** look increasingly destined for relegation after they were comprehensively beaten by **Coventry United** at Pride Park. United ran out 7-1 winners, Sam Lockley and Kai Williams scoring twice, and finished the game with ten men. **Highgate United** eased any relegation concerns with a 4-0 win over **Dunkirk** at The Coppice, Lei Brown with a hat-trick. **Quorn** stay 7<sup>th</sup> following a 1-1 draw at **Boldmere St Michaels**. **AFC Wulfrunians** are a place further back after they too drew 1-1 on their travels at **Loughborough University**.

A late goal from Aiden Thomas gave **Westfields** all three points in a 1-0 win at **Stourport Swifts**. The win moves Fields to within 5 points of the leaders with 8 games remaining.

## Division 1

Only two of the top 6 recorded victories as the promotion race took another twist. Leaders **Heather St Johns** were forced to battle all the way by bottom club **Littleton** before The Saints ran out 3-1 winners. Ben Mackey scored twice for **Racing Club Warwick** who move into 2<sup>nd</sup> with a 3-1 win over **NKF Burbage** at Townsend Meadow. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> time this season, **Lichfield City** were reduced to 10 men against **Atherstone Town** as the game finished goalless at The McDonalds Community Stadium. 5<sup>th</sup> place **Leicester Road** saw their promotion hopes severely dented as they were beaten 2-1 at home by **Brocton**, Andrew Davis with the winner. 6<sup>th</sup> placed **Studley** were also beaten at home, **Rocester** returning to Staffordshire with the points after a 3-0 win with Tom Brown scoring twice. **Cadbury Athletic** were 2 up inside two minutes at home to **Uttoxeter Town** and never looked back, 3-1 the final score with Odane Barnes getting a brace.
