## Review

### Premier Division

Just 5 games survived the weather but there was significant impact on both ends of the table. League leaders **Coleshill Town** found themselves 1 down at **South Normanton Athletic** after 4 minutes. That's how it stayed until 12 minutes from time. The home side were reduced to 9 men and The Coleman were ruthless and scored three goals in a 7-minute spell to extend their lead at the top of the table. **Haughmond** made it three wins on the trot as they beat second placed **Bromsgrove Sporting** 3-2 at The Sports Village. Carl Rogers gave The Mond a first half lead with Richard Gregory equalising just after the break. The home side went 3-1 up and despite a late goal they held on to move 7 points clear of the relegation places. **Shawbury United** are off the bottom as a Benji Robinson hat-trick in the first half gave them a 3-0 win at **AFC Wulfrunians**. **Quorn** won the Leicestershire derby at Farley Way beating **Shepshed Dynamo** 2-0 thanks to first half goals from Dan Brennan and Ryan Seal. **Loughborough University** climbed to 15<sup>th</sup> place in the table following a 4-1 win over **Long Eaton United** who finished the game with 9 men due to injuries. Cameron Gordon scored twice for The Scholars.

Leaders **Coleshill Town** extended their lead to 7 points with a comprehensive 7-1 win over **Long Eaton United** at Pack Meadow. The Coleman never looked back after taking a 3-0 lead inside the first 8 minutes. James Hicks helped himself to a hat-trick while Joe Smith also bagged a brace.

**Worcester City** maintained their promotion push with a 4-2 win at Allpay Park over **Westfields**. The game was tied at 2-2 until the last 5 minutes when a brace from Lee Hughes swung the game in the favour of City.

## Division 1

## Preview

### Premier Division
