Review

Premier Division

Ilkeston Town maintained their 4 point lead at the top of the table as Jamie Walker scored twice in a 3-1 win at **Romulus**. **Westfields** are back up to 2nd, Ben Hayes with a double in their 3-1 win over **Stourport Swifts** at Allpay Park. **Walsall Wood** left it late at **Coventry Sphinx**, Javia Roberts scoring in the last minute as they won 2-1, all three goals coming after the 86th minute. **Sporting Khalsa** slipped to 4th as they went down 2-0 at home to **Boldmere St Michaels** for whom keeper Lewis Fenney was in superb form. **Shepshed Dynamo** are up to 5th, Pearson Mwanyongo scoring the only goal of the game at **Loughborough University**. Luke English scored twice for **Worcester City**, but it was to no avail as hosts **Highgate United** took the points with a 3-2 victory. **South Normanton Athletic** are off the bottom following a 2-1 win over **Long Eaton United**. A stoppage time equaliser from Ryan Richmond for **Quorn** mean it's **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** who take over bottom spot. Dominic Dell scored twice for Sporting in the 2-2 draw. **Dunkirk** scored a last minute equaliser at home to **Coventry United** to draw 2-2 and move level on points with Loughborough University. In the Black Country derby at CKW Stadium, **AFC Wulfrunians** took the spoils with a 2-1 win over **Lye Town**.

Worcester City left it late to gain all 3 points at **Long Eaton United** with two goals in the dying minutes to overturn a 1-0 deficit. The win moves City up to 5th.
