## League News

Thanks to **Uttoxeter Town** who have kindly shared the advice given by Staffs FA to them regarding alcohol at games.

To confirm the rules regards Alcohol pitch side. You'll need to follow the following guidelines. In order of importance.

- 1) Licensing laws – This will overrule everything. You'll need to check your alcohol license to see if this allows you to have alcohol consumed on your site in line with the rules of regulations of your license... If this does not permit alcohol outside of the clubhouse, then you cannot consume alcohol pitch side.
- 2) Competition specific rules – The rules of the competition you are playing in will dictate if alcohol is allowed to be consumed pitch side or not. For example. The county cup finals allowed alcohol consumption, however you may find the league you play in doesn't permit this. In which case you wouldn't be allow to consume alcohol.
- 3) Club rules – Basically. What you decide as a club!! Some allow it, some don't!

## Review

## Premier Division

**Ilkeston Town** took over top spot with a 2-0 win at **Walsall Wood**, both goals in the second-half. **Coventry Sphinx** maintained their unbeaten start to move into 2<sup>nd</sup> place with a comfortable 2-0 win at previous leaders **AFC Wulfrunians**. Two goals from Joe Lawley helped **Lye Town** to a 3-1 win at **Wolverhampton Sporting Community**. **Westfields** made it three wins out of 4 and condemned visitors **Shepshed Dynamo** to a 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive defeat, 4-1 the score at Allpay Park. Tesfa Robinson scored twice in the first half as **Sporting Khalsa** picked up their 1<sup>st</sup> win of the season, 2-0 at home to **Loughborough University**. An Andy Nicol goal after 19 minutes was enough for **Stourport Swifts** to register their first win at home to **South Normanton Athletic** who are searching for their first point. Ryan Shaw scored the only goal of the game early in the second half as **Boldmere St Michaels** beat **Quorn** at Farley Way. **Highgate United** are still to concede a goal and they picked up a point in a goalless draw at **Long Eaton United**. It was the same scoreline at **Dunkirk** as they drew with **Romulus**. **Worcester City** have their first point of the campaign following a 2-2 draw with 10 man **Coventry United** at The Victoria Ground.

## **Preview**

### **FA Cup**

#### **Bedworth United vs Atherstone Town**

The Adders travel to Step 3 Bedworth for what promises to be a cracking local derby. The Greenbacks began their campaign with a 1-1 draw at Biggleswade while the Adders have made a superb start to the season including an excellent 4-1 win at Step 5 Hanley Town in the previous round. A three step difference should mean that Bedworth are favourites however this could be a giant killing.

#### **Grimsby Borough vs Long Eaton United**

Long Eaton travel to the Bradley Development Centre to tackle NCEL Division 1 (Step 6) Grimsby Borough. Borough have started well being unbeaten in 4 league games and with an excellent 3-0 away FA Cup win at Leicester Nirvana. Mark Cooper leads the scoring with 5 goals. Long Eaton are looking for their first league win of the season while Ruben Wiggins-Thomas is the leading scorer following his move from Rugby Town. Long Eaton are the higher ranked side however they will do well to force a replay

#### **Highgate United vs Leicester Road**

#### **Loughborough University vs Cleethorpes Town**

A move to their own ground at Linden has seen a huge increase in attendances and they are anticipated to challenge for honours. #### **Malvern Town vs Racing Club Warwick**

Both of these sides were giantkillers in the previous round. WMRL Malvern beat Boldmere St Michaels in a replay after trailing the Mikes 2-0.
