Premier Division

Walsall Wood returned to the summit following an 8-0 win at **Coventry Sphinx**, who ended the game with 9 men. Jack Till, Joey Butlin and Max Loveridge all scored twice for a rampant Wood. **Heather St Johns** slip to 2nd but remain unbeaten following a 1-1 draw with promotion rivals **Sporting Khalsa** at St Johns Park. **Romulus** are up to 4th with another impressive victory, 2-0 at **Newark Flowserve** who drop to 6th. An early goal from Niall Towle was enough for 5th placed **Long Eaton United** to seal a victory at **Lye Town**. **Gresley** are still without a win as they were beaten by two late Christian Oldham goals for **Haughmond**. **Boldmere St Michaels** continued their resurgence under new boss Neil Kitching, beating **Selston** 3-0 at the TBMG. **Highgate United** slip back into the bottom three as they were beaten 2-0 at **Stourport Swifts**. **South Normanton Athletic** and **Worcester City** shared the spoils with a 1-1 draw at Lees Lane. It was the same scoreline at The Beeches as **Tividale** drew with **Coventry United**, both goals in the last 5 minutes of the game.

Premier Division

Game of the day is at Grange Park as 3rd placed **Long Eaton United** welcome fellow promotion hopefuls **Newark Flowserve**. Long Eaton have won five of their last 6 league games scoring 15 goals in the process. A couple of defeats in their last four games has slowed Flowserve after a fine start to the season. Leaders **Walsall Wood** were beaten in midweek and they will want to bounce back when they travel to Walshes Meadow to face **Stourport Swifts** who they beat 3-0 at Oak Park earlier in the season. **Heather St Johns** are level on points at the top and they take their unbeaten record to Parish Hall to face lowly **Selston**. 4th placed **Sporting Khalsa** welcome **South Normanton Athletic** to the Aspray Arena. Khalsa are without a league win in three and they were beaten 3-1 at Lees Lane back in August. **Gresley** sit adrift at the bottom of the table but they can close the gap if they can pick up their first win of the campaign at home to **Coventry Sphinx**, who will want to put last week's 8-0 defeat at the hands of Walsall Wood behind them. **Boldmere St Michaels** have picked up 11 points from their last five matches since changing their management team and they travel to The Coppice to face 3rd bottom **Highgate United**.
