Review

Premier Division

Leaders **Ilkeston Town** saw their lead cut to 5 points following a goalless draw at **Coventry United**. **Westfields** reclaimed 2nd spot with a 1-0 win over **Lye Town** at Allpay Park, Craig Jones with the goal. **Walsall Wood** drop to 3rd as they were held to a 1-1 draw by **Highgate United** at Oak Park. **Coventry Sphinx** put an end to **Shepshed Dynamo's** long unbeaten run with a 2-1 victory at Sphinx Drive, Ryan Harkin with the deciding goal. **AFC Wulfrunians** remain in 5th place following a 1-1 draw at the CKW Stadium with **Quorn**. **Boldmere St Michaels** are up to 7th as they came from behind to beat **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** 4-1 at The Trevor Brown Memorial Ground. **Romulus** moved 5 points clear of the relegation zone with a 4-1 win over **Dunkirk** at Vale Stadium. **Long Eaton United** maintained their impressive run of results as they beat **Stourport Swifts** 2-0 at Grange Park.

Leaders **Ilkeston Town** saw their lead whittled down to just two points following a 3-0 defeat at **South Normanton Athletic**. Dylan Garnett scored twice for the Shiners who climb to 18th in the table. 2nd placed **Westfields** came from behind to win 4-3 at ten man **Wolverhampton Sporting Community**. Olly Price scored the winner in the 87th minute. **Walsall Wood** are 3rd, Paul Sullivan scoring both goals in their 2-0 win at **Lye Town**. **Coventry Sphinx** won the Coventry derby beating **Coventry United** 1-0 at The Butts Park Arena, Matt Gardner with the goal. **Shepshed Dynamo** bounced back after last Saturday's defeat with a 4-0 win over **Boldmere St Michaels** at The Dovecote. **AFC Wulfrunians** took a 9th minute lead at **Sporting Khalsa** but the home side ran out 4-1 winners despite seeing skipper Tesfa Robinson red-carded in the 2nd half. **Worcester City** slipped to 10th following a 2-1 defeat at **Stourport Swifts**. **Quorn** are up to 9th place edging a 5-goal thriller at Farley Way with **Loughborough University**. **Long Eaton United** maintained their good run, coming from behind to draw 1-1 at **Dunkirk**. **Highgate United** and **Romulus** shared a goalless draw at The Coppice, a game that was delayed 16 minutes due to damage to a goalframe.

Division 1

Heather St Johns took over at the top of the table following a 6-1 win over **Stapenhill** at St Johns Park. Simeon Cobourne scored three and Chris Cowley two as the Saints now have a +53 goal difference. Alex Keating scored twice as **Lichfield City** came from behind to beat **Studley** 2-1 at The McDonald's Community Stadium. **Leicester Road** are 5th, Callum Earls scoring twice in the 6-0 victory over **Heath Hayes**. **Cadbury Athletic** moved into the top 6 with a 4-0 win over 2nd bottom **Nuneaton Griff** at the TSA. Rocester are up to 14th as Jordan Dodd scored twice in a 4-1 win at **Coventry Copsewood**. Lee Osborne scored twice for **Brocton** as they beat **Chelmsley Town** 2-1 at Silkmore Lane. **Paget Rangers** are just two points outside the top 6 after they came away from **Uttoxeter Town** with all 3 points and a 3-1 win.

There was a Boxing Day goal rush for the leading sides in Division 1. Bottom club **Littleton** picked up a point in a 1-1 draw at **Coventry Copsewood**. **NKF Burbage** and **Chelmsley Town** couldn't find a goal between them at Pack Meadow.

Miles Langford scored twice as **Bartestree** went third with a 6-1 win over **FC Shush**. **Central Ajax** and **Alcester Town** are 4th and 5th following a 2-2 draw between the two sides at Old Stratford Road. An equaliser from Shaye Eden 6 minutes from time earned **Shipston Excelsior** a point at home to **Castle Vale Town**. **Coventrians** climb to 6th with a 5-2 win at **WLV Sports**. Premier Division

Coventry Sphinx start off proceedings as they host **Boldmere St Michaels** on Friday evening. A win for Sphinx would move them to within a point of the leaders. **Ilkeston Town** travel to in-form **Stourport Swifts** who have won 5 out of their last 6 including 4 at Walshes Meadow. **Walsall Wood** welcome **Long Eaton United** to Oak Park and a win for the home side would see them in the top two. **Shepshed Dynamo** have two games in hand on the leaders and are in excellent form. They travel to Pride Park to face bottom club **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** whose performances aren't generating the pints they deserve. **Sporting Khalsa** bounced back to form on Boxing Day and they welcome **Quorn** to the Aspray Arena with games in hand on the top four. 19th meets 18th at Lenton Lane with **Dunkirk** welcoming **South Normanton Athletic**. The Shiners will be boosted by their excellent win over the league leaders on Boxing Day and a win for either club will put them right on the heels of the sides above them. **Coventry United** and **Worcester City** find themselves some way off the promotion pack and both will be seeing a win as essential when they meet at The Butts Park Arena. **Highgate United** welcome **Lye Town** to The Coppice and a win for the home side would see them leapfrog their visitors. **AFC Wulfrunians** slipped to 7th with a defeat on Boxing Day and they travel to **Romulus** who have picked up four points from their last two games.
