League News

Boldmere St Michaels are sorry to announce the death of President Harry Peakman who passed away in the early hours of 27 March. Harry who has been associated with the Mikes since 1943 recently passed his 98th birthday whilst confined in Good Hope Hospital Sutton Coldfield with a lung infection'. The details of his funeral will be published in the newsletter as soon as they are known.

At the last meeting it was announced that all Divisions, with the exception of the Premier Division and Division One, will have temporary dismissals ('sin bins') introduced next season. Since the meeting we have now been informed that this will be extended to both the Premier and Division One. This announcement has come as somewhat of a surprise to us and we are currently in consultation with the FA regarding this. If there are any updates on the announcements already on social media, they will be relayed to you as soon as possible.

Worcester City Football Club can confirm that at the General Meeting on 26th March 2019 the resolution to confirm that the vote from the Club AGM on 28th February 2019 to change the constitution to allow for conversion to the community ownership model has been passed by shareholders.

Collectively, the Football Club and Supporters' Trust Boards are unanimously pleased that the resolution was passed and that the process to convert to the community ownership model can finally begin. Both Boards would also like to thank the shareholders for continuing to support the vision of a community-owned Worcester City FC in this second vote.

Chairman Steve Goode said 'it's a great feeling for everyone involved from the Club and Trust to finally have this confirmed after last month's AGM. Once again, we hope that key stakeholders recognise tonight's outcome to finally have the conversion to community ownership confirmed as signifying a break from the past to a prosperous and bright future for Worcester City FC with a brand-new outlook and approach. We know there is still a considerable amount of work ahead to get to where we want to be, but we are excited by what the future could hold for this football club'

Trust Chairman and Club Director Dave Wood added 'We're really pleased to be in a position now where the Club and Trust can finally begin the process to become a community owned club. We're well aware of all the fantastic clubs that have followed this path and made a real name for themselves from doing so. We want this change with its associated values to galvanise supporters and anyone with an interest to get behind the club and to send a strong message that we are determined to be a valued, positive, proactive and permanent feature of the City of Worcester.'

The Football Club and Supporters' Trust will continue to seek the advice of Supporters Direct as we work through this process and beyond to ensure we fully capitalise on this ownership change. Details on how shareholders can transfer their shares to the Supporters' Trust will be released in the coming days.

We will provide updates on this process as it progresses.

The Football Club would like to sincerely thank all those who attended tonight's meeting and those who voted by proxy. In addition, we would like to thank the Cricket Club for once again providing the venue completely free of charge.

Transparency and communication are paramount to the Club and Trust. We will provide updates on the next steps to be taken in due course.

Preview

Premier Division

The battle for promotion sees all three contenders on their travels. Leaders **Ilkeston Town** travel to the CKW Stadium to face 9th placed **AFC Wulfrunians**. Wulfs have lost their last three conceding three goals each time so form favours The Robins. 2nd placed **Walsall Wood** travel to Holywell Stadium to face relegation threatened **Loughborough University**. The Wood are unbeaten in seven and have closed the gap to three points and three goals. The Scholars beat 3rd placed Sporting Khalsa in their last home game and would hope for more of the same. **Sporting Khalsa** face a short journey to Pride Park to tackle bottom club **Wolverhampton Sporting Community**. A defeat for the home side would confirm relegation while Khalsa must win their remaining games to have any chance of finishing top. **Dunkirk** travel to **Boldmere St Michaels** knowing that a defeat would confirm their relegation too. Dunkirk have lost 6 of their last 7 and they will be hoping to repeat the 3-1 victory they had over The Mikes earlier this season. **South Normanton Athletic** are pushing for survival again after last season's great escape and they can do their position the world of good if they can beat **Highgate United** at Lees Lane. The Gate had four players red carded last Saturday and they have to fill those four places this week. **Romulus** have lifted themselves clear of the drop and a win over **Coventry United** at The Vale Stadium would see them climb another place.
