Review

Premier Division

Leaders **Ilkeston Town** had to come from behind to beat **Dunkirk** at The New Manor ground with Elliott Reeves scoring twice in a 3-1 win. **Walsall Wood** stay 3rd after a 1-1 draw at **Sporting Khalsa**. **Shepshed Dynamo** are up to 4th following a 2-0 win over **Long Eaton United** at The Dovecote. **South Normanton Athletic** made it three wins out of 5 as they beat **Highgate United** 5-1 at The Coppice, Ben Robinson scoring twice. Cadbury Athletic vs Desborough Town

Division 1 Cadbury Athletic have never reached the 3rd round before and they welcome United Counties League Desborough Town to the Triplex Sports Arena. The Chocolatemen have done exceptionally well to reach this round and are hard to beat. Desborough recent form has not been great however they did win 2-0 at Worcester City in the previous round.

Coventry United vs Hinckley AFC
