## Review

### Premier Division

Only three points separate the top six after the weekend results. Leaders **Newark Flowserve** were beaten 3-1 at Lowfields by **Long Eaton United**. **Coventry United** are level on points at the top of the table following a 2-0 win over **Worcester City** at The Butts Park Arena. **Sporting Khalsa** are a point behind after they beat **Selston** 7-0 at The Aspray Arena. Selston were reduced to 9 men by the half hour mark and played an hour without a recognised keeper. Liam Armstrong and Gurjit Singh both scored twice for Khalsa. **Romulus** moved up to 4<sup>th</sup> with a convincing 3-0 win over promotion rivals **Walsall Wood** at Castle Vale. **Heather St Johns** fought back from a goal down to draw 1-1 with **Haughmond** at St Johns Park. A goal six minutes into stoppage time from Richard Hanslow earned **South Normanton Athletic** a 1-1 draw at promotion chasing **Stourport Swifts**. **Boldmere St Michaels** ended **Highgate United** recent good run of results with a 3-0 win at The Trevor Brown Memorial ground. **Gresley** are out of the bottom as a Kyle Parchment goal gave them a 1-0 win at **Lye Town** who drop to 19<sup>th</sup>. **Racing Club Warwick** made it five games unbeaten with a goalless draw at home to **AFC Wulfrunians**. It was the same scoreline at The Beeches as **Tividale** and **Coventry Sphinx** couldn't find a goal between them.

**Heather St Johns** moved level on point at the top of the table with a 2-1 win over league leaders **Newark Flowserve** at St Johns Park. Newark were reduced to ten men in the first half but took the lead after the break, through Danny Meadows. Saints scored twice in the last 20 minutes through Brett Lloyd and Malachi Farquharson to win the game. **Walsall Wood** and **AFC Wulfrunians** shared the spoils in an uneventful 0-0 draw at Oak Park.

## Division 1

The battle to finish in the top four intensified with five of the top seven registering victories. The only two of the leading pack not to win played each other at **Leicester Road** with the home side coming from behind to draw 1-1 with 4<sup>th</sup> placed **Lichfield City**. 2<sup>nd</sup> place **Brocton** ruined **Ashby Ivanhoe's** return home after three months by winning 3-1. 3<sup>rd</sup> placed **Studley** gained quick revenge after a midweek defeat at **NKF Burbage** by turning the tables with a 3-0 win at The Beehive. A double from Oli Ritchie helped 5<sup>th</sup> place **Uttoxeter Town** to a 3-1 win over **Cadbury Athletic** at Oldfields. Result of the day saw 6<sup>th</sup> placed **Atherstone Town** win 6-1 at **Rocester**. Ryan Quinn scored three and Alex Naughton two in a game that was far closer than the scoreline suggests. A last minute goal from Ben Kendrick earned **Hinckley AFC** all three points in a 1-0 win over neighbours **Nuneaton Griff**. Jason Holmes scored on the stroke of half-time for **Heath Hayes** as they beat **Chelmsley Town** 1-0. It was a similar scoreline at Sphinx Drive with Jason Evans scoring the only goal of the game for **GNP Sports** against **Stapenhill**. A last minute goal from Morgan Bailey earned bottom club **Stafford Town** a 1-1 draw at **Coventry Copsewood**. **Paget Rangers** and **Kirby Muxloe** battled out a goalless draw at Coles Lane, a result which does neither any favours in the battle at the foot of the table.

**Brocton** closed the gap at the to just 6 points with a 4-2 win at **NKF Burbage**, leading scorer Regan Smith with a brace. **Uttoxeter Town** moved into the top four with a fine 3-0 win over **Heath Hayes** at Oldfields, Dan Harper scoring twice. **Lichfield City** slip to 5<sup>th</sup> as they were beaten 2-1 at **Rocester**. Madundo Semahimbo scored twice for **Coventry Copsewood** in their 3-2 win over **Hinckley AFC** at Allards Way.
