Premier Division (43)

Walsall Wood 3 AFC Wulfrunians 5

On a murky evening, a short trip to Oak Park for a game featuring two sides who had poor results at the weekend. Walsall Wood were well beaten by Tividale while Wulfs were in a shocking run of form that had seen them plummet towards the bottom of the table. Talk before the game was of Wulfs inability to score with very little confidence from their supporters that things would change. As it was, they must have feared the worse when The Wood took the lead after 60 seconds. A long ball found Joey Butlin, who brought the ball down and flicked it into the path of Harry Harris and his first-time volley gave John Bateman no chance. Wulfs were level 4 minutes later. Jake Webb picked up the ball in midfield, surged forward and threaded the ball out to the right-hand touchline to Craig Gregg. Gregg crossed low into the box where Tom Grainger beat the defender to turn it past Lewis Gwilliams. The goal lifted the visitors and Gregg, finding space on the right, saw another cross headed clear. In the 10th minute, Scott Rickards beat the Wulfs offside trap to race clear on the right but his shot was narrowly off target. Wulfs came close to taking the lead after 15 minutes. Webb found space on the right and his cross was volleyed onto the top of the bar by Grainger. Wulfs were looking the more confident while The Wood were reliant on the strength of Butlin up front. On the half hour mark, excellent control by Butlin created an opportunity but he was well marshalled by Matthew Hunt and the chance was gone. Wulfs took a deserved lead in the 34th minute. Jacob Barnes, not for the first time, found space on the right and his cross was touched back into the path of Mark Ganderton who fired home with the help of a slight deflection. A good break by Charlie Shaw on the Walsall Wood right saw the youngster flash the ball across the face of goal. A minute before the break, Wulfs should have extended their lead. John Hill played the ball inside the defender and into the path of Webb. Webb raced clear but his shot was wide of the target,

Wulfs started as they had finished with Webb and Jake Sedgemore having attempts on goal. Butlin forced a fine low save from Bateman. From the resulting corner delivered by Drew Aiton, Adam Wood headed wide. Wulfs missed another glorious chance in the 58th minute when Webb beat Shaw down the left and his low ball in evaded Gwilliams but Grainger could only turn the ball wide. In the 65th minute, Wulfs thought they had scored when Hill powered home a Sedgemore free-kick but the offside flag was up. Within a minute, Walsall Wood were down to 10 men when Harry Harris was shown a second yellow card following a challenge in midfield which was right in front of the referee. Wulfs took full advantage and grabbed their third in the 72nd minute when Grainger converted Webb's right wing cross. Two minutes later, the home side pulled a goal back. Aiton's initial effort was saved but Liam Molesworth was on hand to force the ball home. It took Wulfs less than a minute to regain their two-goal lead. A mistake by Gwilliams saw the keeper play the ball straight to Webb and he made no mistake. The goals didn't stop there as Wulfs scored their 5th in the 81st minute. Demetri Brown did well to control the ball under pressure, took the ball to his right and lifted the ball over Gwilliams, who had raced off his line, and into the net. Butlin responded for the Wood rattling the post from close range. Webb should have made it 6 when he outstripped the home defence but shot over the bar. In the 84th minute, Louis Harris was bundled over in the penalty area and stepped up to make it 3-5. Mitch McDonald almost grabbed a sixth for Wulfs but Gwilliams made a fine save,

What a crazy game of football. A thoroughly enjoyable game as a neutral but Wood will point to the sending off of Harry Harris as a turning point. Wulfs were well in command at that point but with only a goal in it, who knows where the game would have gone.

Review

Premier Division

Leaders **Alvechurch** had to come from 2 goals down to rescue a point at **Heanor Town**. The Lions led 2-0 at the break but goals from Daniel Dubidat and a Ryan Edmunds gave Alvechurch the point. **Lye Town** closed the gap to 5 points with a 3-0 win at home to **Shepshed Dynamo** with Ben Billingham scoring twice. **Coleshill Town** are 15 points behind the leaders with 4 games in hand. They were comfortable 4-0 winners at **Rocester** with Jordan Nadat bagging a hat-trick. At the bottom, **Tividale** picked up a vital three points with an excellent 3-1 victory at **Walsall Wood** with Chris Bladen scoring twice. A penalty from Simeon Maye gave **Boldmere St Michaels** all three points in the vital relegation clash with **AFC Wulfrunians**. **Stourport Swifts** took a 2-0 lead at home to **Long Eaton United** but the visitors came back to earn a point. A double from Shay Brennan helped **St Andrews** to a 3-1 win at **Loughborough University**.

Coleshill Town moved up to 3rd place following a 4-2 win over **Tividale** at Pack Meadow. Jordan Nadat scored twice for the Colemen who had to come from behind to win. **Sporting Khalsa** are up to fifth thanks to a Shawn Boothe goal at **Loughborough University**. There was a remarkable game at the ML Safety Stadium as **AFC Wulfrunians** put their recent poor run behind them to come away with a 5-3 victory over **Walsall Wood**. The Wood were in front after just 60 seconds but Wulfs took a half time lead. That's how it stayed until the last 20 minutes with 5 goals and a red card.
