Review

Buildbase FA vase Round 3

The late change of opponents didn't impact too much on **Lye Town** as they beat Leighton Town 4-0 at The Sports Ground after extra-time. **Shepshed Dynamo** won the all Leicestershire clash with **NKF Burbage** 3-0 at The Dovecote. **Sporting Khalsa** were 3-1 winners over 10-man **Walsall Wood** at The Aspray Arena. **Ilkeston Town** welcomed local rivals Eastwood Community to the New Manor ground and it was the visitors that progressed, winning 2-1. **Westfields** hosted United Counties League Leicester Nirvana and it was the East Midlands side that are in Round 4 after a 4-0 victory.
