League News

Uttoxeter Town Football Club are looking for a volunteer to take over as being the Club Secretary.

Uttoxeter Town play in the Midland League- Division 1 and is a fully chartered club, with a committee of 7 volunteers.

The role involves liaising with the Midlands League and Staffordshire FA to register all the players at the beginning of the season via an online system. During the season, the Secretary ensures all confirmation letters are sent to opposition teams for home and away games, via the club emails.

After each game, the secretary uploads the results each week onto the Midlands League system and facilitates the paying of any fines received during the games.

The season starts at the beginning of August and finishes at the beginning of May each year and the role is busy during August when registering all players, then settles down to 2hrs per week, for letters for the next game are sent and results are uploaded onto the system.

The Football Club Committee has 5 meetings per season at Oldfields Sports and Social Club, Springfield Road, Uttoxeter, which is the clubs home ground and the secretary takes minutes for these meetings and liaises with the committee to ensure all decisions are implemented.

Full training will be given and a manual for both Midlands League and Staffordshire FA system will be provided.

Preview

Premier Division

With a shortened programme, game of the day sees 5th placed **Shepshed Dynamo** hosting 4th placed **Sporting Khalsa**. Khalsa beat Shepshed 2-0 on their previous meeting in January and both sides need a win to close the gap at the top. **AFC Wulfrunians** and **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** try again at Castlecroft following last Saturday's postponement due to the weather. **South Normanton Athletic** are 7 points from safety and they travel to **Lye Town** who are unbeaten in 5. **Loughborough University** are one place above the drop zone, and they welcome 9th placed **Worcester City** to Holywell. Four straight wins have lifted **Long Eaton United** to 11th in the table and a home win against **Coventry United** would lift them into the top 10.

Division 1

Leader's **Heather St Johns** travel to Coles Lane to face mid table **Paget Rangers**, Heather winning the reverse fixture 5-0. 2nd placed **Lichfield City** have won their last 6 and they travel to relegation threatened **Nuneaton Griff**. 3rd placed **Racing Club Warwick** are on an even better run, winning their last seven. They travel to the Welfare ground to face **Hinckley AFC** who are 13th. **Atherstone Town** have games in hand on the top two and they welcome **Cadbury Athletic** to Sheepy Road. Four straight wins have lifted **Leicester Road** back into contention and they travel to **Uttoxeter Town** who beat them 4-2 back in August. At the foot of the table. **Littleton** are 11 points adrift of safety and they welcome 15th placed **Rocester** to 5Acres. 16th meets 17th at Allards Way in a game that could have a big bearing on the relegation battle with **Coventry Copsewood** playing host to **Heath Hayes**. **Chelmsley Town** welcome **Studley** to Pack Meadow with the visitors chasing a top 6 finish. **Brocton** have seen 126 goals in their 25 league games, so entertainment is pretty much guaranteed when they welcome **NKF Burbage** to Silkmore Lane.

Northfield Town can extend their lead at the top of the table if they can overcome visitors **Lane Head**. 3rd placed **GNP Sports** have games in hand on the sides above them and they can take closer order if they beat **Coton Green** at Sphinx Drive. Bottom club **Earlswood Town** entertain 4th placed **Fairfield Villa** who will want bounce back after defeat last week. **Bolehall Swifts** welcome **Hampton** to Rene Road and a win for Swifts could see them within touching distance of safety. 5th placed **Moors Academy** travel to the Robin's Nest to face **Knowle** who are unbeaten in three. 14th meets 12th at Knight's Lane with **FC Stratford** and **Feckenham** needing points to climb away from the foot of the table. **Coventry Alvis** have played 9 games less than some teams which has left them in a lowly 13th place.
