Buildbase FA Vase Quarter Final

Atherstone Town's excellent run in the FA Vase came to an end at the hands of Northern League Consett AFC. The Adders took the lead in the first half through Ryan Quinn with Jermaine Metz equalising after the break. In extra time, two goals from Calvin Smith in the first period earned Consett the victory and a two-legged semi-final against Bitton.

Premier Division

Leaders **Coventry United** extended their lead to four points with a 3-1 win at **South Normanton Athletic**. Second place **Sporting Khalsa** saw their long winning run brought to a halt by visitors **Tividale** who won 1-0 thanks to a Dan Smith goal fifteen minutes from time. **Walsall Wood** are up to 6th, Michael Nelson scoring both goals in their 2-0 win over **Newark Flowserve** at Oak Park. Both sides finished the game with ten men. **Gresley** and **Selston** shared the spoils at The Moat Ground. The game finished 1-1 with both goals from penalties. **Coventry Sphinx** continued their fine run of form with a 3-1 win at **Haughmond**, despite being reduced to ten men in the first half. **Worcester City** came from behind to beat **AFC Wulfrunians** 2-1 at The CKW Stadium.

Romulus moved level on points with 2nd placed Sporting Khalsa, following a 3-1 win at Racing Club Warwick. **South Normanton Athletic** came from behind to beat **Lye Town** 2-1 at The Sports Ground. New signing Kienan Palmer gave the Flyers the lead but goals from Martin Smyth and an own goal, the winner in the 93rd minute, gave The Shiners the points.

Division 1
