Review

Premier Division

League leaders **Ilkeston Town** bounced back to winning ways with a 4-1 win over **Shepshed Dynamo** at the New Manor Ground. Jamie Walker netted a hat-trick for the Robins. **Walsall Wood** maintained the three point gap and improved their goal difference with a 7-0 win at **Dunkirk**. Mitch Tolley scored a brace of second half penalties for The Wood. 3rd placed **Westfields** lost ground on the top tow as they went down to a 2-1 defeat at **Coventry United**, Tyler Haddow with the winner for the home side. **Sporting Khalsa** moved into 4th place but they also lost ground on the top two as they were held to a 1-1 draw by **Coventry Sphinx** at The Aspray Arena. At the bottom, **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** twice held the lead at home to **Highgate United**, but it was the visitors that took the points with a 3-2 win. Umar Zaman scored twice for Wolves with Lei Brown scoring twice for The Gate. **South Normanton Athletic** remain in the relegation zone as they went down to a 2-1 home defeat at the hands of **Boldmere St Michaels**, who are now 6th. **Loughborough University** are one place and three points ahead of the Shiners as they were beaten 1-0 at Holywell by **Long Eaton United**, Mason Rowley with the goal in first half stoppage time. **Romulus** are 7 points clear of danger following an impressive 2-0 win at **Worcester City**. **AFC Wulfrunians** slip out of the top 6 as they were beaten 3-1 at **Stourport Swifts**.

Division 1

The match of the day didn't disappoint with promotion chasing **Racing Club Warwick** and **Lichfield City** drawing 3-3 at Townsend Meadow. Lichfield took a 3-0 lead late in the first half but a goal on the stroke of half-time gave The Racers hope. With City down to 10 men, Warwick pulled a goal back before seeing themselves reduced to 10 men. Into stoppage time, the Racers found an unlikely hero with a goal from keeper Charlie Bannister to earn what could be a vital point. League leaders **Heather St John's** are now 7 points clear after coming from behind to beat bottom side **Nuneaton Griff** 6-1 at St John's Park. Dean Rathbone scored twice as Heather racked up league goal 119 for the season. **Atherstone Town** closed the gap on 2nd place with a 2-0 win at **Littleton**, Ryan Quinn and Alex Naughton with the goals. **Leicester Road** aren't giving up on a top two finish just yet as they recorded a 3-0 win at home to **Cadbury Athletic**. **NKF Burbage** are 6th but they needed a late goal from Tom Smith to rescue a point at home to **Rocester**. Jake Avery scored an injury time winner for **Uttoxeter Town** at **Brocton**, 2-1 the final score. **Paget Rangers** kept **Heath Hayes** looking over their shoulder with a 6-0 win at The Coppice Colliery Ground. Michael Wright scored three and Ross Dempster two for The Bears. **Hinckley AFC** ended a run of defeats as they drew 1-1 at **Coventry Copsewood**. **Stapenhill** fine run of results was ended by **Chelmsley Town** who won 1-0 at Edge Hill.

Preview

League Cup Semi Final

Romulus welcome **Ilkeston Town** to the Vale Stadium for the first of this year's semi-finals. Romulus are unbeaten in eight since they lost at Ilkeston in January. The Robins hold a three point lead at the top of the table and are looking to finish the season with a league and cup double. This is likely to be a tight affair with both sides in good form.

Premier Division

A shortened programme but no lack of interest across the games. **Loughborough University** welcome **Sporting Khalsa** to Holywell with both sides in need of 3 points for contrasting reasons. The Scholars find themselves struggling near the foot of the table while Khalsa must win to maintain their promotion challenge. **Westfields** are the other promotion chasing side in action and they host in-form **Highgate United**. On the opening day of the season, Highgate ran out 2-0 winners at The Coppice and expect this one to be a close run thing. **South Normanton Athletic** avoided relegation on the final day of last season and they are doing everything they can to repeat the feat this. They travel to 7th placed **Coventry Sphinx** who won the reverse fixture 1-0. **Boldmere St Michaels** had a slow start to the season otherwise they may well be in the promotion mix. They travel to mid-table **Worcester City** looking to strengthen their top 6 placing. **Lye Town** welcome **AFC Wulfrunians** to The Sports Ground needing points to confirm their place in the Premier Division next season.

Division 1

The battle for promotion continues with four of the top five all in action. Leaders **Heather St Johns** welcome **Rocester** to St Johns Park. Heather have won their last 19 games in all competitions and have a healthy 7 point lead at the top of the table. Rocester have had a strong second half of the campaign but won't need reminding that Heather beat them 6-1 on the opening day of the season. A return of 5 points from their last 4 games has seen **Racing Club Warwick** hand over the advantage at the top of the table and they will be looking for three points when **Brocton** visit Townsend Meadow. **Atherstone Town** are just a point behind the Racers and they travel to Welfare Ground to face **Hinckley AFC** who halted a run of defeats with a point last weekend. **Leicester Road** have managed to cling to the coat tails of the top four and any slip ups could yet see them in the top two. They host **Stapenhill** who they beat 6-0 back in October. Bottom club **Nuneaton Griff** host 16th placed **Coventry Copsewood** and with the likelihood of only one team being relegated this season, a point would see them off the bottom. **Heath Hayes** are anxiously looking over their shoulder with the two sides below them just 5 points adrift. They welcome **Cadbury Athletic** to The Coppice Colliery Ground with The Chocolatemens on a run of three straight defeats.

Division 2

With leaders Northfield Town not in action, the focus is on the three sides chasing them to see if they can close the gap. 2nd placed **Boldmere Sports & Social Falcons** need to win their three remaining games to draw level on points with the leaders and they face a tough challenge with 6th placed **Coton Green** the visitors. 3rd placed **Moors Academy** know that a top two finish could see them promoted and they welcome **Redditch Borough** to the TBMG. **GNP Sports** have lost their favourites tag due to a run of just one point from three games.
