Premier Division

A goal 5 minutes from time from George Forsyth gained **Worcester City** a vital 3 points with a 1-0 win at leaders **Coleshill Town**. **Bromsgrove Sporting** took full advantage to take over at the top as they came from 1-0 down to win 2-1 at **Rugby Town**. Jason Cowley grabbed the winner for Bromsgrove midway through the second half. 3rd placed **Sporting Khalsa** left it late to gain all 3 points at home to **Lye Town**. Lye took the lead through Brandon Hague on the hour and a Mykel Beckley penalty 10 minutes from time looked to have earned Khalsa a point. Three minutes into time added on, Jak Jeys curled a free-kick past former Khalsa keeper Tm Turton to keep the home side in the promotion hunt. **Coventry Sphinx** are back up to 5th, coming from 2-0 down to draw 2-2 at **Boldmere St Michaels**. Ryan Harkin was the man with the equaliser in the 92nd minute. 2nd bottom **South Normanton Athletic** moved their game against **Quorn** to Farley Way but it was the home side that emerged with the points with a goal in each half in a 2-0 win. **Shawbury United** held a 2-1 lead at home to **Westfields** with 15 minutes to go, thanks to a brace from Sean Evans. Preview

Premier Division

Leaders **Bromsgrove Sporting** travel to Ludlow Stadium to face an improving **Shawbury United**, battling to climb out of the bottom three. **Coleshill Town** will look to bounce back from their home defeat last week when **Lye Town** are the visitors to Pack Meadow. A last gasp winner last Saturday maintained **Sporting Khalsa's** promotion push and they travel to **Loughborough University**. **Worcester City** gave their promotion chances a huge lift last week with victory at Coleshill Town. They welcome **Coventry United** to The Victoria Ground in what should be another big test. **Highgate United** are within striking distance of the top two and they have a tough trip to Allpay Park to face **Westfields**. **South Normanton Athletic** are 6 points short of safety in the bottom three and they travel to mid-table **Long Eaton United**. Two of the sides just outside the relegation zone meet at The Sports Village with **Haughmond** hosting **Stourport Swifts**. **Coventry Sphinx** promotion challenge has faded picking up just two points from the last 12. They travel to the Dovecote to face mid-table **Shepshed Dynamo** in a game that should be good for the neutral. **Boldmere St Michaels** have been in fine form of late and they travel to The Town Ground to face **Heanor Town**, comfortably in the top half of the table. **Rugby Town** are in 7th place but probably too far adrift to challenge for promotion this season. They travel to Farley Way to face a **Quorn** side who find the net regularly at home.

Division 1

Leaders **Walsall Wood** welcome **Chelmsley Town** to the ML Safety Stadium and when the two sides met at Pack Meadow in August, Walsall Wood won 7-0. If it's goals you are looking for, The New Manor Ground should be the place to go as high-flying **Ilkeston Town** entertain the division's second highest scorers, **Heather St Johns**. 2nd placed **Atherstone Town** travel the short distance to the McDonalds Community Stadium to tackle mid-table **Lichfield City**. **Leicester Road** travel to Oldfields to face **Uttoxeter Town** and when the two sides met at the end of 2017, Uttoxeter came from 3-0 down to draw 3-3. **Hinckley AFC** will be hoping to play their first home game since Boxing Day as **Studley** visit St Johns Park. **Racing Club Warwick** have games in hand on all their promotion rivals and they face mid table **Coventry Copsewood** at Allard Way. At the bottom, **Coventry Alvis** are 10 points adrift of safety and they will need to go on an excellent run, starting at **Paget Rangers** this week, if they are to avoid relegation. **Bolehall Swifts** and **Cadbury Athletic** are locked together on 20 points with Swifts in the bottom two courtesy of an inferior goal difference. The game at The TSA takes on huge significance for both sides. **Stafford Town** climbed out of the bottom two last time out and they will be hoping to back that up when in-form **Littleton** are the visitors to Evans Park. **Brocton** are another side in the relegation dogfight and they travel to **Pershore Town** who are 9 points ahead of them in the table. **Heath Hayes** welcome **Nuneaton Griff** to the Coppice Colliery Ground and with both sides far from clear of the relegation zone, three points for either would be a huge boost.

Division 2

Fingers will be crossed for a full programme of fixtures after the decimation of recent weeks. Leaders **NKF Burbage** travel to Walshes Meadow to face an improving **Droitwich Spa**. 2nd placed **Hampton** travel to 8th placed **Earlwood Town**, Hampton winning the reverse fixture 2-1 in January. 3rd placed **Montpellier** welcome bottom club **Pelsall Villa** to the Beehive the two sides battling out a goalless draw when they met at the ML Safety Stadium. **Redditch Borough** are currently in the relegation zone with four other sides within 2 points. They host 4th placed **Knowle** who have realistic ambitions of promotion. Two wins has lifted **Fairfield Villa** to 9th and they can continue their rise with a win at relegation threatened **Bloxwich Town**. **Moors Academy** are also in that battle at the foot of the table and they welcome 6th placed **Feckenham** to Tally Ho!

Division 3

Leaders **GNP Sports** have a 13 point lead at the top of the table and have scored 17 goals in their last three games. They travel to Hall Drive to face **Envile Athletic** who have lost their last 4. **FC Stratford** are in 9th but have many games in hand on all the sides above them.
