Review

Premier Division

Alvechurch now have a four-point lead at the top of the Premier Division following a 1-0 win at **Shepshed Dynamo**, Josh March with the goal in the 12th minute. There was a dramatic game at Allpay Park where **Lye Town** took a 2-0 lead at **Westfields** with just 5 minutes left. Craig Jones pulled a goal back almost immediately and a goal 4 minutes into stoppage time from James Febery meant the points were shared. **Coleshill Town** lost ground on the top three as they were beaten 4-2 at **Boldmere St Michaels** for whom Alister Brauns opened the score after just 23 seconds. **Sporting Khalsa** are up to 5th as they beat **Heanor Town** 2-1 at The Aspray Arena with the winner coming late on from Elliott Turner. **Coventry United** are 6th as they beat **Walsall Wood** 2-0 at Sphinx Drive. There was a 7 goal thriller at **St Andrews** as the home side raced into a 4-0 lead over **Loughborough University**, Shay Brennan scoring twice, but three goals in the last 7 minutes from the Scholars made it a tight finish. **Coventry Sphinx** had an excellent win on the road, beating **AFC Wulfrunians** 4-1 at Castlecroft with Jamie Towers scoring twice. At the bottom, **Brocton** are now 10 points from safety after they were beaten 4-1 at Silkmore Lane by **Long Eaton United** with Michael Towey and Kevin Hemagou both scoring twice. Improving **Tividale** picked up another three points, beating **Quorn** 3-2 at The Beeches. A Nathan Hodge brace helped **Shawbury United** to a 3-0 victory over **Stourport Swifts** at Wem. Marco Adaggio was another striker to score twice as **Highgate United** overcame **Rocester** 3-0 and moved up to 15th in the table.

Westfields were held for the second time in 4 days as they drew 1-1 at **Loughborough University**. The Scholars took the lead with 11 minutes left but Richard Greaves ensured a point with 5 minutes left.

Premier Division
