Review

Buildbase FA Vase Round 4

Result of the round belongs to **Atherstone Town** who travelled to FA Vase favourites Stockton Town and made it through to Round 5 with a 1-0 win. Joe Obi scored the only goal of the game late in the second half to the delight of the Adders supporters. **Sporting Khalsa** join them in Round 5 after they beat Kirkley and Pakefield 2-0 after extra-time. Sean Williams and Mykel Beckley were on target for Khalsa. **South Normanton Athletic** took a 16th minute lead through Richard Hanslow at home to Thurlow Nunn high-flyers Wroxham Town. They held the lead until the 64th minute but goals from Chris Skipper, Grant Holt and Charlie Clarke saw the Yachtsmen through. A goal just after half-time from Louis Dodds settled the game between West Auckland Town and **Walsall Wood** in the Northern League sides favour. Premier Division leaders **Newark Flowserve** travelled to Lancashire to face Longridge Town and their FA Vase run ended with a 5-1 defeat. Tom Ince scored a hat-trick for Longridge while Ben Hutchinson was on target for The Highwaymen.

Worcester City and **Coventry United** met on Wednesday night after their game on Sunday was washed out. United took an early lead but a double from Marco Adaggio sent City through to the last 16. A tasty trip to Atherstone Town is the reward and it is sure to attract a large crowd.
