Smithswood Firs are pleased to announce that we will be ground sharing with Lichfield City from the start of the 2018/19 season. The move was proposed and sanctioned months ago with Lichfield City and the Total Motion Midland Football League which means we will be playing at The McDonalds Community Stadium next season.



It is an exciting time for the club and while The Glades has been a good home to us, we needed to make the move to a facility that could match our ambitions of playing Step 6 football next season. Promotion was secured last night with a combination of us beating Fairfield Villa 2-1 and Droitwich Spa losing 3-0 at Bloxwich Town so we have achieved our aim from the start of the season of securing promotion to Division 1 for next season.

We would like to thank Mark Finnegan at The Glades for his support over the last few seasons. He put a lot of work into the ground to allow us to meet the criteria that the League wanted which included building new toilets next to the players dressing rooms and he has the ground for Step 7 level now and should be welcoming another MFL team from next season to replace us.



Our new home is a fantastic facility with an excellent 3G surface and two stands for supporters. Neil Armstrong and Paul Ryder met with Lichfield City Chairman Darren Leaver initially and after a tour of the ground and facilities, we knew it was a perfect fit for Smithswood Firs and Darren and the club have been fantastic in getting everything finalised with the League. They even helped us out during the bad weather allowing us to play our home match against Pelsall Villa there which we won 3-1. The surface is perfect for our players and the way we like to play football and it is a positive move for the club as we look to move onto the next level.
