Review

FA Vase

Boldmere St Michaels left it late to beat Rugby Town, Joe Lyng scoring in the last minute to seal a 2-1 win. In a thriller at Silkmore Lane, **Brocton** equalised 5 minutes from time against **Highgate United** to send the game into extra-time. James McGrady scored his second and Brocton's third of the game to enable the Badgers to beat their higher ranked MFL opponents. Jake Brown gave **NKF Burbage** the lead after just 50 seconds at Bustleholme and it was a lead they held throughout the game. Brown added another as Burbage ran out 4-1 winners. **Cadbury Athletic** are through to the 2nd round of the Vase for the first time in their history following a resounding 4-0 win over Hanley Town. **Ilkeston Town** are through to Round 2 with a 3-0 win at The Town ground over Heanor Town. The game was clinched 6 minutes from time with the Robins scoring two goals in a minute to finally see themselves over the line. **Paget Rangers** travelled to Hereford and were knocked out of the competition by Hereford Lads Club, 2-0 the result. **Loughborough University** entertained Division 1 front runners **Heather St Johns** and looked to have taken the game into extra time when Christian Enemeradu equalised Matt Gardner's opener. Heather failed to read the script and leading scorer Simeon Cobourne sent them through with an injury time winner. **Lye Town** saw off Division 1 opposition in **Chelmsley Town** winning 5-2 at The Sports ground with Joe Lawley scoring twice. **Romulus** will travel to Wellington for a replay on Tuesday thanks to a last minute extra time equaliser from Mitch Piggon, 3-3 the final score. Two first half goals from Jordan Wakeling and Joe Pheasant earned **Shepshed Dynamo** a 2-0 win over Bewdley Town at The Dovecote. **Walsall Wood** saw off WMRL opposition at Hillcrest Avenue beating Smethwick Rangers 3-0. A goal from Dan Westwood was enough to clinch victory for **Sporting Khalsa** at home to Winsford United. Tyler Weir scored twice for **Worcester City** as they overcame league rivals **Long Eaton United** 2-1 at The Victoria ground.

Coventry United eased past WMRL Wednesfield at Butts Park Arena, Shaquille MacDonald scoring twice in their 5-0 victory. **Quorn** went down to ten men at Belper United but a brace from Henry Eze helped them on the way to a 4-1 win.

Two goals from Dimitri Dunkley in the second half saw **Romulus** through to a 2nd round tie at Westfields after they beat Wellington 3-1 in a replay.
