Review

Premier Division

Bromsgrove Sporting moved three points nearer to promotion with an emphatic 7-1 win at bottom club **Rocester**. There were 5 goals in the opening 18 minutes as Bromsgrove raced into a 4-1 lead. Richard Gregory and Jason Cowley both scored twice as they pursue the Golden Boot for the division. Joe Boachie scored three as **Loughborough University** moved 6 points clear of the relegation zone with a 4-1 win over **Lye Town**. **Westfields** are up to 8th as they continued their fine form with a 1-0 win over **Coventry Sphinx** at Allpay Park, the winner courtesy of an own goal from Sam Wanless. Craig Reid got the only goal of the game as **Coventry United** beat **Boldmere St Michaels** at The Trevor Brown Memorial Ground.

Leaders **Bromsgrove Sporting** are 1 point from promotion after coming from behind to beat **Haughmond** 3-1 at The Victoria Ground. **Coleshill Town** are 2nd on goal difference as they were held 1-1 at resurgent **Westfields** who are up to 7th. **Highgate United** made it 6 wins on the spin as Marco Adaggio scored all four in their 4-0 win at **Long Eaton United**. **Worcester City** are 4 points off a promotion spot following a 1-1 draw at **Boldmere St Michaels**. At the bottom, **Shawbury United** held a 2-0 lead at **Rocester** into the final 5 minutes but goals from Oli Roome and Martin Smyth earned The Romans a point. That result saw Shawbury slip into the bottom three as **South Normanton Athletic** had a comfortable 3-0 win at **AFC Wulfrunians**. **Quorn** came from 2-0 down at home to **Coventry Sphinx** to win 4-3, Jamie Towers scoring twice for Sphinx. **Lye Town** are up to 15th, Nathan Stone scoring the only goal of their game at home to 6th placed **Rugby Town**. **Loughborough University** made it two wins in three days as Alex Dinsmore scored twice to beat Coventry United 3-2, the game played at **Boldmere St Michaels**.

Quorn climbed up to 9th place following a 7-1 win over a depleted **Coventry United** at Farley Way. Ryan Seal scored twice for the home side. Jamie Sleigh scored a hat-trick as **Heanor Town** beat **Stourport Swifts** 5-1 at The Town Ground to move into the top half of the table.

Highgate United moved clear in 2nd place with a 4-2 win at bottom club **Rocester**. The Romans twice held the lead, but Marco Adaggio scored his second hat-trick in four days to cement the win. **Worcester City's** promotion hopes are hanging by a thread as they were held 1-1 by **Stourport Swifts** at Walshes Meadow. **Shawbury United** remain in the bottom three as a Joe Lyng goal earned **Boldmere St Michaels** all three points at Ludlow Stadium. Jake Betts scored the winner for **Shepshed Dynamo** as they beat **Long Eaton United** 2-1 at The Dovecote.

Coventry United and **Coventry Sphinx** couldn't find a goal between them in the Coventry derby at the Butts Park Arena. **Heanor Town** made it two excellent wins in a week with a 3-0 victory over **Westfields** at Allpay Park. **South Normanton Athletic** moved three points clear of safety following a 1-1 draw at home to **Quorn**.

Division 1

Stafford Town climbed out of the relegation zone with a shock 2-0 win at **Racing Club Warwick**, Taylor Allen with both goals. Bottom side **Coventry Alvis** came from behind to draw 3-3 with **Pershore Town** at Green Lane, Charlie Anagho-Ntamark scoring twice for the visitors.

Walsall Wood need 8 points from 7 games to clinch promotion at the first attempt as they travelled to Worcestershire and beat **Pershore Town** 7-1. Paul Sullivan scored 5 for The Wood who have now scored 136 goals this season. Chasing them on the goalscoring front are **Hinckley AFC** who beat landlords **Heather St Johns** 6-1 at St Johns Park with Steve Hart scoring 4 and Kai Tonge two. Two goals apiece from Wade Malley and Sean Kavanagh meant **Racing Club Warwick** bounced back to form with a 5-2 win at **Uttoxeter Town**. **Ilkeston Town** kept the pressure on the leaders with a 2-0 win over **Littleton** at The New Manor Ground. **Leicester Road** are clear in 3rd as they beat 9-man **Atherstone Town** 2-1 in the A5 derby. It's getting interesting at the bottom with **Coventry Alvis** threatening to pull off a remarkable escape. They beat **Heath Hayes** 3-2 at Green Lane moving them to within 7 points of safety and with 3 games in hand. **Stafford Town** moved out of the relegation zone on Thursday night with a superb 2-0 win at Racing Club Warwick, but they couldn't back it up as they were beaten 2-0 at **Cadbury Athletic** who are up to 18th. **Chelmsley Town** beat **Nuneaton Griff** 4-1 at Pack Meadow to move to within a point of their visitors, Curvin Ellis scoring twice. **Brocton** slip to 19th following a 2-0 defeat at **Coventry Copsewood**. A goal from Dan Ludlow earned **Studley** all 3 points at home to **Paget Rangers**.

Atherstone Town moved into 4th place following a 4-0 win over **Stafford Town** at The Mark Webster Community Stadium. The result leaves Stafford 1 point outside the relegation zone having played 4 games more than the sides below them.

Walsall Wood need two more points to secure the Division 1 title as they returned from the Beehive with all 3 points following a 6-0 win over **Studley**, Lei Brown scoring twice. Nearest challengers **Ilkeston Town** were beaten 4-2 at **Racing Club Warwick** for whom Martin Slevin converted two penalties. In the battle for third, **Hinckley AFC** were beaten 2-0 at St Johns Park by **Littleton** who move up to 10th. **Cadbury Athletic** climb top 17th following a 2-1 win at **Heath Hayes**. A last-minute goal from Declan Arber earned **Brocton** a 2-2 draw at Silkmore Lane against visitors **Coventry Copsewood**. **Uttoxeter Town** and **Lichfield City** shared the spoils in a 1-1 draw at Oldfields.

Tom Duffy scored twice as **Stafford Town** moved 4 points clear of the relegation zone with a 3-2 win at **Coventry Alvis**.
