Review

Premier Division

League leaders **Ilkeston Town** travelled to the Victoria Ground and were well beaten by **Worcester City** who climb above them in the table. Goals from James Baldwin, Matt Birley and Jordan Harrison gave City a 3-0 victory while the Robins finished with 10 men following a red card for Matt Baker. **Westfields** are the new leaders after Craig Jones scored twice in a 4-0 win at **Sporting Khalsa** who had won their previous 7 league games. Jordan Nadat scored twice as **Walsall Wood** maintained 5th place with a 2-1 win over **Quorn**. **AFC Wulfrunians** are a point further back as they continued their excellent season with a 2-1 win at bottom club **South Normanton Athletic**. Ryan Harkin bagged a hat-trick for 7th placed **Coventry Sphinx** in their 5-2 win over **Long Eaton United**. **Shepshed Dynamo** were reduced to 10 men at **Dunkirk**, but they brushed that off to win 5-1 with both Matt Melbourne and Celson Patricinio scoring twice. **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** were denied a victory in stoppage time at **Highgate United** when Arron Brown grabbed an equaliser, 1-1 the final score. **Stourport Swifts** climbed a place to 14th with a 2-0 win over **Lye Town** at Walshes Meadow. **Loughborough University** and **Romulus** are 16th and 15th respectively after they fought out a 2-2 draw at Holywell.
