Review

Premier Division

Highgate United pulled four points clear of 3rd placed Coleshill Town but they had to come from 2-0 down to draw 2-2 at **Haughmond**. Skipper Aaron Brown scored from 30 yards to make it 2-1 after Harry Morris and Joe Parry had given the Mond a 2-0 lead. Brown was then sent off for dissent before top scorer Marco Adaggio grabbed an equaliser 5 minutes from time. **Rocester** picked up their first win since November as they beat **Shawbury United** 2-1 at Ludlow Stadium. In a game of three red cards, the result leaves both in the bottom three. **Loughborough University** made it three wins in a week thanks to Matty Crookes 87th minute winner at **Stourport Swifts**.

Bromsgrove Sporting lifted the Premier Division title with a 3-1 win at **Loughborough University**. Richard Gregory, John Pykett and Jason Cowley on target for the champions. The race for the second promotion spot intensified as 2nd place **Highgate United** were beaten 3-0 at **Worcester City** keeping City's faint hopes alive. **Coleshill Town** took 58 minutes to break the deadlock at home to **Rocester** and then the floodgates opened with the Coleman winning 7-0. Matt Gardner scored three as Coleshill close the gap on Highgate to just one point. At the foot of the table, **South Normanton Athletic** moved 6 points clear of the drop with a 2-1 home win over **Boldmere St Michaels**, Jack Tyson with the winner. **Haughmond** grabbed a last-minute equaliser at The Sports Village to draw 1-1 with **Coventry United** who had two players sent off. **Shawbury United** saw their survival hopes take a huge dent as they lost their third home game in a week, going down 3-1 to **AFC Wulfrunians** for whom Dominic Moan scored twice. 5th placed **Sporting Khalsa** were beaten 3-2 at the CKW Stadium by **Quorn** who finished the game with 10 men. **Heanor Town** made it 5 wins on the trot as they beat **Lye Town** 2-1 at The Town Ground with Jamie Sleigh scoring twice. **Rugby Town** came from behind to beat **Shepshed Dynamo** 3-2. Liam Read scored twice for Shepshed but it was Sam Belcher who scored the decisive goal with 8 minutes left. **Long Eaton United** beat **Westfields** 2-1 at Grange Park, all the goals coming in the last 20 minutes. **Stourport Swifts** put any fears of relegation to bed with a 2-1 win at Walshes Meadow over **Coventry Sphinx**.

Highgate United went down 3-1 at **Sporting Khalsa** to make it one point from their last three matches, all within a 5-day spell. It looked as though Gate might salvage a point but two goals in the last 6 minutes strengthened Khalsa's hold on 5th place. **South Normanton Athletic** have saved their best form till the end of the season and they pulled 8 points clear of relegation with a 3-1 win at **Coventry United**. Kieran O'Connell scored twice for The Shiners who relegated Rocester with this result. Steve Hole equalised 5 minutes from time for **Haughmond** at **Coventry Sphinx**, but they now need to win their 3 remaining games and hope results go their way.

Champions **Bromsgrove Sporting** suffered a serious hangover as they were thumped 5-0 by **Lye Town** at Stourbridge Road, Jack Till scored twice for The Flyers who were 3 up at half-time. **Worcester City** closed to within a point of 2nd following a 4-0 win over relegated **Rocester** at The Victoria ground. It was 0-0 until the 57th minute but Dave Reynolds scored twice to keep Worcester's season well and truly alive. A goal 6 minutes from time from Jerry Puemo gave **Stourport Swifts** a 2-1 win over in-form **Heanor Town** at Walshes Meadow.

South Normanton Athletic made it 16 points from 6 games as they beat **Sporting Khalsa** 4-2 at the MJ Structures Arena, Marcus Tudgay with a brace. **Haughmond** are relegated despite a 5-1 win at **Coventry United**. The home side took the lead in the 59th minute but the Mond responded with three goals in 11 minutes. **AFC Wulfrunians** and **Stourport Swifts** shared 6 goals in an entertaining game at CKW Stadium. **Long Eaton United** beat **Heanor Town** 2-1 at The Town Ground thanks to 2 goals inside the opening 19 minutes. **Shawbury United** kept their survival hopes alive and dragged **Loughborough University** into the battle as they beat the Scholars 3-0 at Ludlow Stadium with Keanu Cooper scoring twice.

Division 1

Ilkeston Town ensured that the promotion race would continue for a couple more days at least as they beat **Heath Hayes** 3-2 at The Coppice Colliery Ground. **Hinckley AFC** climbed to 4th following a 3-2 win at St Johns park over **Chelmsley Town**, Luke Richards scoring twice. **Atherstone Town** slip to 5th as they were beaten 4-1 by **Racing Club Warwick** at The Mark Webster Community Stadium, Luke Cole scoring twice for The Racers. Simeon Cobourne added 2 more goals to his impressive tally as **Heather St Johns** beat **Uttoxeter town** 3-2 at Oldfields, James Curley scoring twice for the home side. **Bolehall Swifts** remain 4 points adrift of safety following a 4-0 home defeat at the hands of **Brocton** for whom Joe Hartshorne scored twice. **Littleton** are up to 8th as they beat **Cadbury Athletic** 3-1 at the TSA. **Studley** are in a four-way battle for 8th place and they were boosted with a 3-1 win at **Coventry Copsewood**.

Walsall Wood were crowned Champions following an exciting 4-3 win over **Racing Club Warwick** at The Scholars ground. Lei Brown gave The Wood the lead after just 52 seconds, but The Racers were level after 10 minutes through Sean Kavanagh. Peter Till scored a screamer before two Paul Sullivan goals just after half-time seemingly made it safe for the home side. Trea Bertie scored twice in the last 10 minutes but Walsall Wood held on to take the title with 5 games remaining. The battle for a top three spot saw **Leicester Road** beat **Chelmsley Town** 2-1 with a stoppage time winner from Sam Munton. **Hinckley AFC** boosted their goal difference with a 9-2 win over **Bolehall Swifts** at St Johns Park. James Williams scored three, Richard Lavery and Luke Richards 2 as Hinckley move on to 130 league goals for the season. Two goals in the last 5 minutes gave **Atherstone Town** a 2-0 win at **Paget Rangers** to maintain their top three challenge. At the bottom, **Stafford Town** picked up their 2nd win in succession to move 7 points clear of the drop. Jordan Dodd scored twice as Town beat **Pershore Town** 3-1 at Evans Park. **Brocton** climbed to 16th as a Ryan Burns goal 5 minutes from time earned them a 1-0 win at **Littleton**. **Uttoxeter Town** took a 3-0 lead at **Studley**, James Curley scoring twice, before the home side came back to draw 3-3, Lewis Clarke also getting a brace. The league's leading scorer Simeon Cobourne scored two more to take his tally to 67 goals as **Heather St Johns** beat **Nuneaton Griff** 3-0 at The Pingles Stadium. Tom Green scored late on for **Lichfield City** as they beat **Cadbury Athletic** 1-0. Mark Potts scored twice for **Heath Hayes** in their 3-1 win over **Coventry Copsewood**.

Chelmsley Town climbed two places to 17th following a 2-0 win over **Coventry Copsewood** at Pack Meadow.

Champions **Walsall Wood** hosted 2nd placed **Ilkeston Town** and it was The Robins who inflicted the Wood's first home defeat with a 4-1 victory with Tim Hopkinson scoring twice. Mitch Thomson scored a hat-trick for **Atherstone Town**, who climb to 3rd, with a 4-1 win at **Hinckley AFC**. Luke Cole scored twice for **Racing Club Warwick** in their 4-1 win over **Cadbury Athletic** at Townsend Meadow. **Coventry Alvis** remain 13 points adrift of safety as they went down to **Uttoxeter Town** 5-2 for whom Oli Ritchie scored a hat-trick. **Bolehall Swifts** are the other side in the drop zone and they were beaten 6-0 by **Coventry Copsewood** at Rene Road, Liam Davies scoring twice. **Studley** are up to 10th following a 3-2 win at **Heath Hayes**, Regan Smith scoring twice for the home side. **Littleton** hold the all-important 8th place beating **Paget Rangers** 3-1 at 5 Acres, Danny Carter with two for the Ton Boys.

Promoted **GNP Sports** suffered their first defeat of the season going down to an Alex Andrews goal at **FC Stratford**. The result moves Stratford into 4th with games in hand on their promotion rivals. Two of those in promotion contention fought out a 1-1 draw as 3rd placed **Boldmere Sports & Social Falcons** were held by **Central Ajax**.

GNP Sports lifted the Division 3 title in emphatic style with a 7-2 win over promotion rivals **Central Ajax**. Following defeat at **FC Stratford** on Thursday, there must have been some apprehension when Ajax took the lead in the 2nd minute through Joe Wright.
