Premier Division

Ilkeston Town opened up a 4 point lead at the top of the table thanks to a 2-1 win over **Quorn**. Elliott Reeves scored the winner for The Robins with 4 minutes remaining. 2nd placed **Westfields** needed an 88th minute penalty from Mark Magee to earn a share of the spoils in a 2-2 draw at Allpay Park against **Coventry United**. A Lee Chilton penalty just after half-time settled the game in **Sporting Khalsa's** favour as they beat **Worcester City** 1-0 at The Victoria Ground. **Walsall Wood** are making inroads at the top as they moved to within 2 points of third place following a 2-0 win at **Long Eaton United**. A goal from Liam Hurst just before the hour mark earned **Shepshed Dynamo** all 3 points at home to **Romulus**. **AFC Wulfrunians** stay 6th following a goalless draw with **Stourport Swifts** at The CKW Stadium. **Wolverhampton Sporting Community** came from behind to pick up a point in a 1-1 draw with **Loughborough University** at Pride Park. **Lye Town** are 9th after a 3-1 win at The Sports Ground over **Dunkirk** who are just above the relegation zone. **Boldmere St Michaels** and **Highgate United** shared a 1-1 draw at The Trevor Brown Memorial Ground, a result which leaves both sides in mid-table.
